## SUMMARY OF RELEVANT POINTS:

Minister of Justice KOYAMA, Matsukichi reports on the May 15th Incident, explaining the beginning of the plot as planned among farmers and the members of the secret society, "Temple of Defense of the Fatherland" (GOKOKUDO). The "Party of Assassination" (KETSUMEIDAN) is described as having been organized for the purpose of removing corruption in political circles through assassination of prominent political figures.

OKAWA, Shumei, at that time Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Economic Investigation Bureau of East Asia, is reported to have been the leader of the May 15th Incident and to have prepared pistols, bullets, and money to be given to the defendants.

The remaining part of KOYAMA's report consists of the naming of the participants and a description of their organization into three groups under the leadership of sub-Lt. MIKAMI, sub-Lt. KOGA, and sub-Lt. NAKAMURA and a listing of the political figures these three groups were responsible for assassinating.
