· Population displacements continue in the north-western governorate of Idleb on the border with Turkey. Since the weekend, shelling and bombardment in areas surrounding Idleb city have taken place daily. Estimates of the number of displaced vary as families are seeking refuge in

many dispersed villages, mostly north and west of Idleb. Humanitarian organizations are scaling up arrangements to assist the displaced and affected

Deliveries of humanitarian assistance across the border from Turkey continue despite border restrictions adopted by Turkish authorities since early March.

SOMALIA - Forced evictions

- The number of forced evictions in Mogadishu are again on the rise, as an estimated 2 700 - 5 000 households have been evicted from their houses during the first week of March and more are expected. Overall, in the months of January and February, more than 25 700 internally displaced persons have been evicted from public and private buildings in Mogadishu by the Federal Government. Forced evictions have also been reported in other areas of the country, notably Kismayo, Bosasso and Luug.
- ECHO partners and the Protection and Shelter Clusters are responding to the immediate needs.
