At the advice of the caseworkers she made up her mind to learn dress-making in the occupation agency at the Dogo "Boshiryo", which is specialized for widows. Its new term is to begin in April and she will be graduated in six months. Until she gets trained as a dress-maker, it is recommended that relief money of about 200 yen should be given her so that she may devote herself to her learning without worrying about how to get means of living.

She has made a remarkable advance in her idea of self support, and is going to take a resolute step in consideration of her future. When she accomplishes the training course she will be able to get independent income. It is recommended that Minsei-iiin should encourage her and take means of letting her apply for the training course which begins in April.

As a great deal of sweet oranges are raised in the village from this month on, she could work in picking them off and selecting them and packing them. She could lend two of the four rooms to some war-sufferers or repatriates. Two rooms are enough for her and her two daughters. I advised her to do so.

Yukiko needs thirty-two yen and a half for schooling, and nine yen for train fare monthly. If Koryū works, I think she can manage to send her to school without relief money. Her fine housing shows that they are not so distressed. Relief money should not be given to a family like this.
