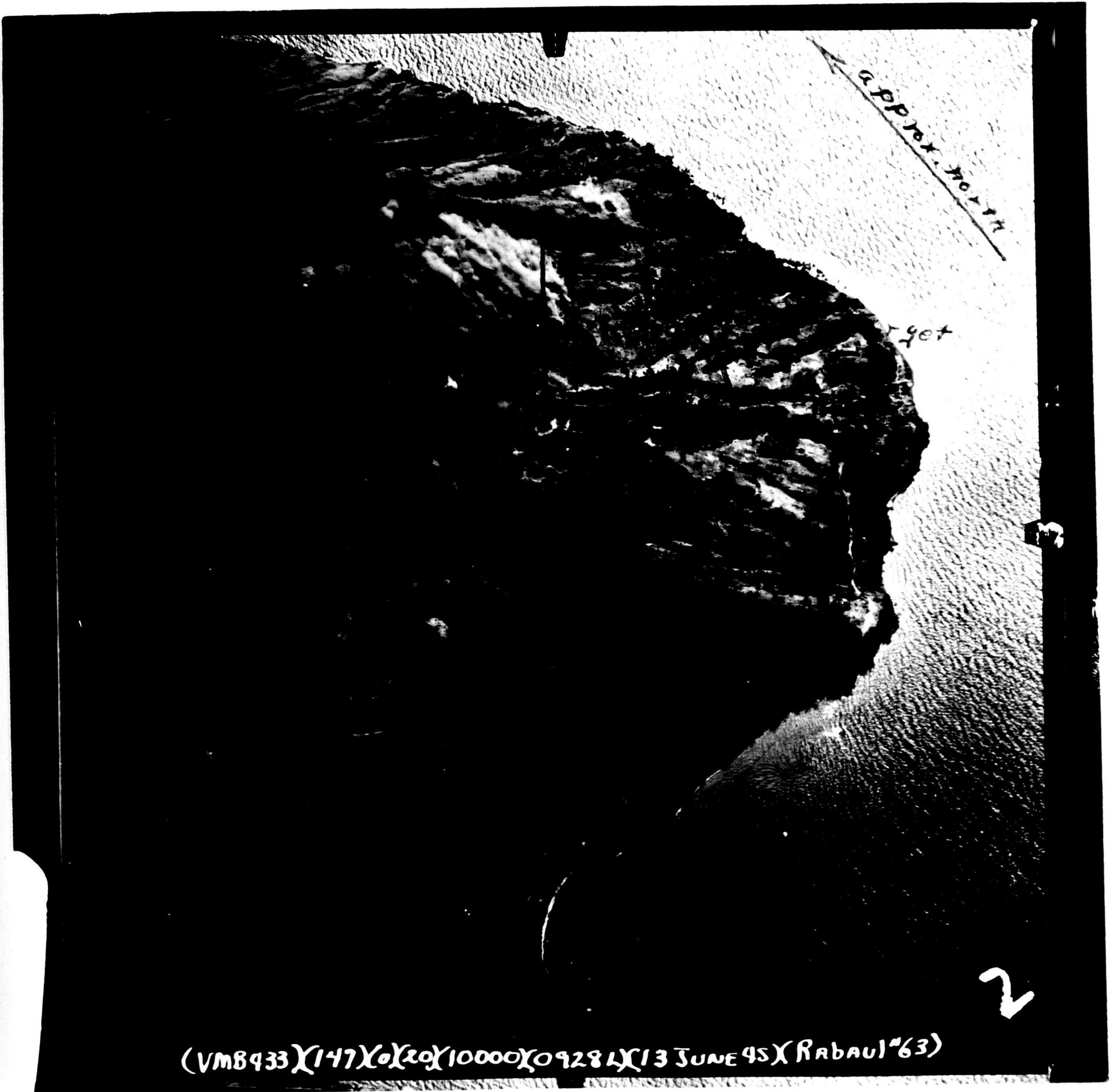
(o) RESULTS: (For all hits claimed on ship targets and for land targets of special interest, draw diagram, top or side view or both, as appropriate, showing type and location of hits. - 1.-60 x 100# GPs landed in an area 500' square with the southern edge along the northern edge of the target. Some of the bombs fell in a ravine where great activity has been observed.
- 2.-24 x 250# GPs landed from 300' south of the target to the eastern edge for no apparent damage. Landed among the plantation trees.
- 16 x 250# GPs landed in the western end of the target, clearing away vegetation, destroying one large building and generally neutralizing that area.
- 8 x 250# GPs landed 200' north of the target for no damage.
- 3.-15 x 1000# GPs extended from 50' to 300' southwest of the target. The bombs fell in open areas. Post-strike photos revealed no apparent damage.
