SUBJECT: Allocation of Cotton yarn for Production of Fish Nets
 for Export during the 3rd quarter of 1947.

1. Reference is made to Memorandum BOTE - 7533-11-384 dated 24 November 1947 requesting the allocation of 1,000 bales of 20's count yarns from the 1947 Third quarter Export Production for use in manufacturing fish nets for export.

2. Pursuant to paragraph 6 of Memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 334 (3 Apr 46) ESS/IE, (SCAPIN 854), dated 3 April 1946, subject: Board of Trade (Boeki Cho), the Board of Trade is directed to allocate 1,000 bales (400,000 lbs.) of 20's cotton yarn produced from CCC-1 cotton during the 3rd quarter 1947 Export Production period to the appropriate fish net manufacturers indicated in Table No. 1 attached.

3. The above 1,000 bales of 20's yarn are to be allocated from the 1947 Third quarter export production of the following mills:

4. The allocation and distribution of the above yarn will be under the general supervision of the Textile Bureau. Each fish net manufacturer described in Table 1 will be instructed to proceed with the manufacture of fish nets without delay. The yarn allocated by this memorandum will be used solely in the production of fish nets for export and may not be used for any other purpose without approval from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Economic and Scientific Section.

BASIC: MEMORANDUM FOR: The Board of Trade (Booki Cho), (BE-47-1141)

5. Inasmuch as provision for the expert manufacture of fish nets was not made in the 1947 Third quarter Expert Production Plan, these 1,000 bales of yarn, must of necessity be allocated from yarn stocks originally intended for use in the manufacture of expert fabrics incorporated in the 1947 Third Quarter Expert Production Plan. Proper adjustment for this emergency allocation will be made by the Board of Trade when the 1947 Fourth quarter 1947 Expert Production Plan is prepared.

6. Form IE-100, "Application to Prepare for Export", covering fish nets to be manufactured under this allocation of cotton yarn will be submitted without delay to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Economic and Scientific Section.
