

Having first duly sworn an oath as on attached sheet,  
and in accordance with the procedure followed in my country  
I hereby depose as follows:

1. I(SUZUKI, Isamu) am 45 years old, living at No. 48 NAKASUGIYAMA-Dōri, SENDAI-City, and now working at KITA Police Station of SENDAI-City as a police inspector of the MIYAGI Prefecture.
2. In July, 1945 I was living in police residence at No. 1, YAGURA-chō, JOZENJI-Dōri, SENDAI.
3. About the air raid of from July 9 to dawn of 10, 1945 I will state as follows:
4. At 9:30 p.m. of July 9, 1945 the warning alarm was issued for TOHOKU South Area and I went to the Police Station immediately, but at about 10:22 p.m. it was removed, so I returned to my house. However, at 10:56 p.m. the warning alarm was issued again, so I went to the Police Station and was warning there. At 10:5 a.m. of 10th the air raid alarm was issued and soon afterward formations of from 5 to 10 B-29, approximately 80 airplanes, invaded in the sky of SENDAI and attacked in waves for 5 to 10 minutes dropping little incendiary shells or oil incendiary bombs of 50 Kilogramme concentrically on the region from the stationed place of army

in KAWACHI in City to KATAHIRA-CHÔ, HIGASHI  
2 BAN-CHÔ, TATEMACHI and KI-CHÔ, namely  
that is, the centre of economy, culture and  
education. Then the great fire broke out  
and the citizens wanted to escape to air raid shel-  
ters or to places of safety, and appeared a  
heart-rending scenes. I saw everywhere  
such families as whole of which were killed  
by hits straight shot or were smothered to death  
in air raid shelters.

877 dead, 870 injured, 100 missed, 5,482 suffered,  
2,250 turned-houses, 400 half-turned, 2,000  
square meters turned and the loss of ¥  
200,000,000 had resulted from this air raid.

5. At about 9 a.m of 10th I returned home  
and found that my house was reduced to  
ashes. Then I urged inquiries everywhere  
in the burned area. In some place I saw  
that 24 blackened corpses by the fire without dis-  
tinction of age or sex lying one upon another.  
As bombs dropped concentrically on the con-  
gested, centre district, so considerable damage  
was done, I think.

Having first duly sworn an oath as on attached sheet and in accordance with the procedure followed in my country I hereby depose as follows:

1. I(SUZUKI, Isamu) am 45 year old, living at No.48 NAKASUGIYAMA-Dōri, SENDAI-City, and now working at KITA Police Station of SENDAI-City as a police inspector of the MIYAGI Prefecture.

2. In July, 1945 I was living in police residence at No.1, YAGURA-Chō JOZENJI-Dōri SENDAI.

3. About the airraids of from July 9 to dawn of 10, 1945 I will state as follows:

4. At 9:30 p.m. of July 9, 1945 the warning alarm was issued for TŌHOKU South Area and I went to the Police Station immediately, but at about 10:22 p.m. it was removed, so I returned to my house. However, at 10:56 p.m. the warning alarm was issued again, so I went to the Police Station and was warning there. At 00:05 a.m. of 10th the airraids alarm was issued and soon afterward formations of from 5 to 10 B-29, approximately 80 airplanes, invaded in the sky of SENDAI and attacked in waves for 5 to 10 minutes dropping little incendiary shells or oil incendiary bombs of 50 kilogramme concentrically on the region from the stationed place of army in KAWACHI in City to KATAHIRA-Chō, HIGASHI 2 BAN-Chō, TATEMACHI and KI-Chō, that is, the centre of economy, culture and education. Then the great fire broke out and the citizens wanted to escape to airraids shelters or to places of safety, and appeared a heart-rending scenes, I saw everywhere such families as whole of which were killed by straight shot or were smothered to death in airraids shelters. 877 dead, 870 injured, 100 missing, 5,482 suffered, 2,250 burned-houses, 400 half-burned, 2,000 square meters burned and the loss of ¥ 2,00,000,000 had resulted from this airraids.

5. At about 9 a.m. of 10th I returned home and found that my house was reduced to ashes. Then I urged inquests everywhere in the burned area. In some place I saw that 24 blackened corpses by the fire without distinction of age or sex lying one upon another. As bombs dropped concentrically on the congested, centre district, so considerable damage was done, I think.
