- b. The proposed amendment to Article 9 Para 1 is reasonable in view of the amendment to list in Article 2 Para 1;
- c. Supplementary Provision No. 1 appears to be standard procedure;
- d. Supplementary Provision No. 2 abolishing Cabinet Order No. 303 of 1950 appears to be reasonable in as much as this Cabinet Order is now outdated by the establishment of additional Agencies.

1. Proposed amendment to Article 2, para 1 of Law No. 105 provides for the establishment of Japanese Government Overseas Agencies in additional countries. In view of the fact that GHQ, SCAP, has approved the establishment of such Agencies DS considers this amendment appropriate.

2. DS has no objection to proposed amendment of para 1 and deletion of para 3 of Article 9 of Law No. 105 which would provide a realistic basis upon which the Minister for Foreign Affairs may determine the amounts of overseas and living allowances paid to personnel of Japanese Government Overseas Agencies. Increases or reductions, within reasonable limits, of existing overseas and living allowances will be based on the individual official's position at Japanese Government Overseas Agencies in the United States and on the official's position, the cost of living, and the dollar rate of exchange at Japanese Government Overseas Agencies' in countries other than the United States.
