Wikipedia Education Program

OVERVIEW

We have been organizing WEP projects in Greece since 2010 in various schools, mostly in universities but also in secondary schools.

All levels (primary, secondary, graduate, postgraduate) So far, we have worked with **25** educators We have mobilized **10** volunteers

TERTIARY EDUCATION

We give assignments to University students in cooperation with University teachers. The assignments include Infoboxes analysis and standardization, translation of articles from/to Greek, new article creation, major article expansions, etc.


Participants per department

ONLINE EDUCATION

As a training platform, the Digital School was built in a website that was created using the popular Wordpress software, which is mainly used to create blogs but it is also used to run major websites from large organizations around the world. The courses prepared included the following elements:



SECONDARY EDUCATION



Real-time online courses via Skype/YouTube platform.



In 2017 we organised CorfuPedia; a student project with main purpose to introduce students to Wikipedia, via creating new articles on their local history, in Corfu, Greece. The students of the cooperating schools, proposed the project to their teachers, after realizing that there are not many articles referring to the local history of Corfu in Wikipedia.





We have been implementing school projects in Second Chance Schools and Adult Education since 2012. Our activities include adding new content in Wikipedia, Commons, Wiktionary, outreach and much more. The school project implemented of the Second Chance School of Corfu in 2015 won many awards in national level.
