Check eligibility criteria for your pictures

They should be self-taken, uploaded during the contest period, contain an identified natural monument, have a free license and at least 2Mpx of size.

Go ahead and upload your beautiful pictures!







WIKI LOVES EARTH 2021 **HOW TO ORGANIZE**

Contest period: May 1 – June 30

dates are flexible, your contest can be held also close to these months, for example, in April or July

Create/join a team in your region/country

Local contests are typically organized by one team per region/country. Check if there is any in yours at w.wiki/35Kr



Reach out to the international team at wle-team@wikimedia.org.ua to join the team in your region/country or to create your own, and to get more info about the next steps.



Coordinate the contest

Create a website/landing page, prepare a list of nature monuments, promote the contest! Some funding for promotion and prizes would help to draw attention.

Set up a jury that selects 10 winners for your country (a technical tool will be helpful w.wiki/KYB); announce them on Commons or to the international team by the deadline.

Competition rules

We try to keep the competition clean and simple to participate. There are only a few rules for photos to participate in the contest in the Philippines. Let's quickly go through them. Every submission should be: 1 All entries must be your own work; do not manipulate original images and make sure that there is no visible watermarks.

- 2 All photos must be uploaded within 1 May to 30 June 2022, to be eligible.
- All photos must be licensed under CC BY-SA license»
- Participants must have an active email account, if the organizers wish to contact.
- Upload photos from the protected landscapes and seascapes, and natural parks in the Philippines.
- Captions and description are required.
- Do not forget to add categories to your picture as it will be helpful to everyone looking for your picture.
- Make sure that you are not uploading duplicate images.

Next to that, there are a few practical rules:

- Sign in or Create a New Account on Wikimedia Commons
- Name your photos well.
- Use our Upload Button at the top OR Click here» to upload images.
- Share your upload success on social media with our hashtags: #WLEPH #WLE2022.
- And wait patiently for the results! All the best!

Judging criteria

The jury will determine the winners of the international contest taking into the consideration the following criteria (in no particular order):

- Technical quality (sharpness, use of light, perspective etc.);
- Originality;
- Usefulness of the image for Wikipedia.

Images that reach a top ranking of the international finale, will typically at least fulfill the technical criteria of the 'Featured Image' process at Wikimedia Commons. But feel free to submit images, and let the jury be concerned if they are good enough.



JURY TOOLS

- Montage is a photo evaluation tool used in Wiki Loves competitions.
- WLX Jury Tool is an image selection and rating tool for photo contests, for example, Wiki Loves Monuments and Wiki Loves Earth.


In 2018, 32 countries participated in Wiki Loves Earth.

The Philippine edition received 1906 images from 185 participants.





In 2019, 37 countries joined Wiki Loves Earth.


The 2nd PH edition had less than 900 entries from 154 participants, 84% of which are new contributors.


The 4th PH edition had 1005 entries from 198 participants, 89% of which are new contributors.



LEARNINGS





What worked well:

- Through the community outreach activities, we were able to reach individuals and groups, which helped increase awareness about the contest as well as the Wikimedia movement.
- Social media has proven its reach and influence.
- Conducting WLE PH is like hitting two birds with one stone; being able to promote the beauty of the country and orient people about Wikipedia since we do not have a large number of contributors.
- Collaboration is the key.







What did not work so well:

- There were several reports from the participants whose user account and/or IP address was blocked therefore they failed to participate in the contest.
- Unknown usernames had been vandalizing the contest page so there's a need to check it from time to time.
- The internet speed in the Philippines is also frustrating whether it is WiFi connection or mobile data.
