

### EXPLANATIONS.



This amusing game can be played from one to any number. From a pack of common playing cards, pick out three aces, three deuces, three trays, three fours, etc., and three tens, altogether thirty cards. Let each card represent its own face value, and the tens for 0. For an example: A five-spot, a seven spot, and a three-spot reads question No. 573; a ten, a six, and a four-spot reads No. 064; a ten, a ten, and a two-spot reads No. 002; all three nines, No. 999; and all three tens, 1,000.

Mix the cards well up, spread them out on the table, and let each person draw three cards and lay them down face up, in order as drawn. The holder of the highest number, who will be the Teacher, must keep this book in his possession, because nobody else must look into it. The Teacher will also receive a paper from each player, with his or her name written thereon fifteen times. Cut the papers up into slips, with a name on each slip. Mix the slips well in a hat or box, and the fun commences.

The Teacher draws one slip from the hat. It reads, "Jones." Mr. Jones has to draw three cards one by one, face up. The cards read, "No. —," and the Teacher gives him the question his number alludes to. If answered correctly, his slip will be returned; if not, Mr. Jones can buy another draw for a cent, and if not the second time answered correctly, his slip will disappear in the pocket of the Teacher, and Mr. Jones has to pay a forfeit when the hat is empty.

If any of the players is detected whispering or aiding his neighbor, the Teacher holds this person liable to a fine of two cents, which goes into the treasury to reward the winner. At each and every drawing, the thirty cards must be spread out upon the table; and if there should be another copy of this book discovered among the crowd, to be used for a malicious purpose, the members will cause said person to be immediately and without further ceremony expelled from the order.

### FORFEITS.

There are a good many methods of paying a forfeit.
