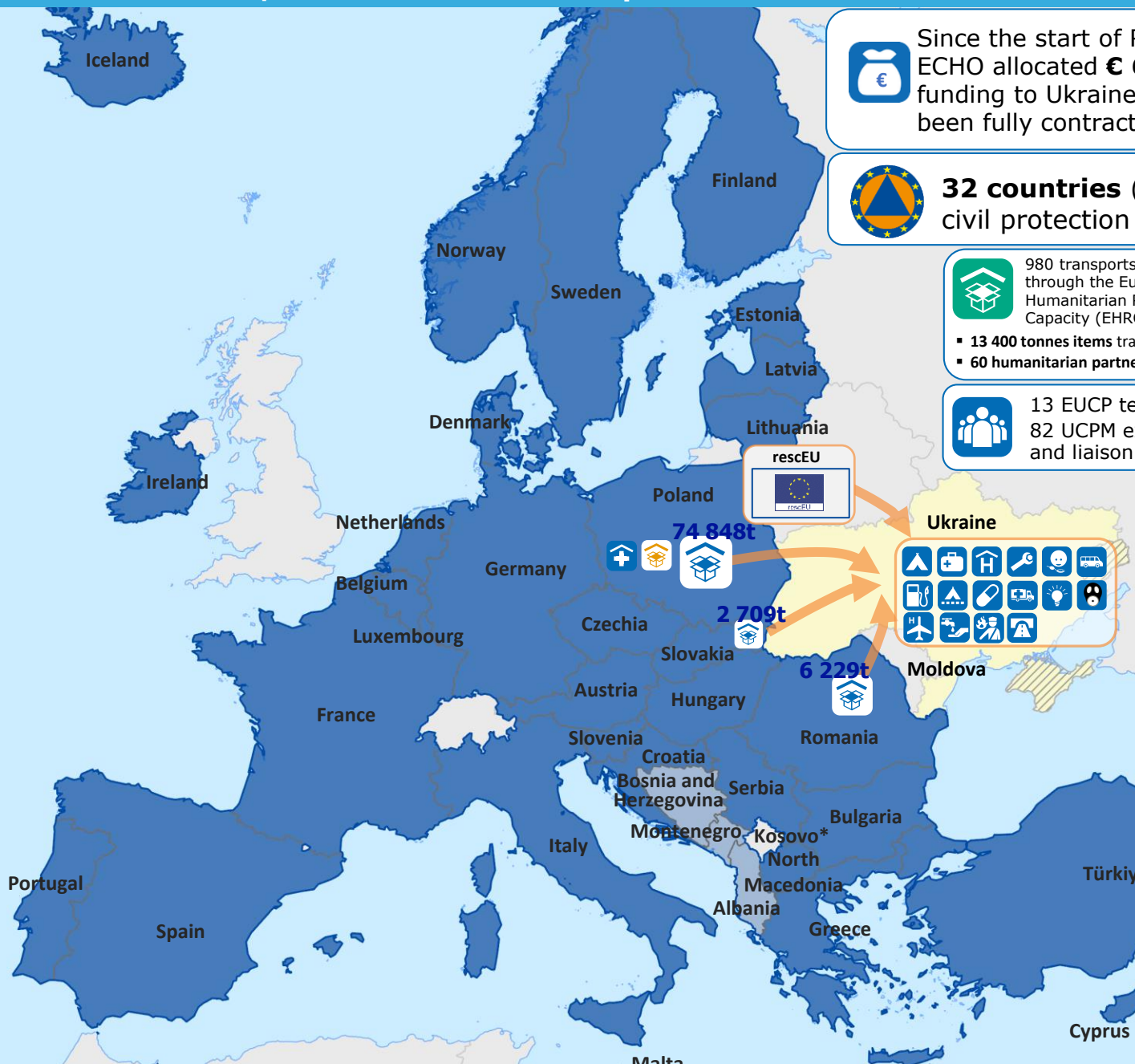


Russia's war on Ukraine | EU Civil Protection Response and Humanitarian Aid to Ukraine



Since the start of Russia's invasion in Ukraine, DG ECHO allocated **€ 630M** in humanitarian aid funding to Ukraine, of which **€ 485M** has already been fully contracted

32 countries (all 27 MS and 5 PS) provided civil protection assistance

980 transports executed through the European Humanitarian Response Capacity (EHRC)

- 13 400 tonnes items transported
- 60 humanitarian partners supported

€556M assistance value
86 183 tonnes delivered through Union Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM)

13 EUCP teams
82 UCPM experts and liaison officers

1 970 MEDEVAC completed operations

2 067 Power generators offered
