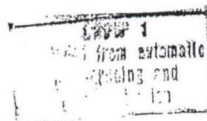

- In July of this year Subject, now designated CATRANSIT-28, replied to an FCB-inserted part-time help wanted ad in his local newspaper. On 14 August [ ] alias Identity-1, contacted Subject at his home for an initial assessment, which was favorable. Upon receipt of a POA, the writer, as Identity-2, recontacted Subject on 22 October and invited him to Wiesbaden, where the JERMINUM and LOFLUTTER tests were given him on 23 November. Following the tests the writer sought and received Subject's agreement to perform a CATRANSIT mission. Prior to his leaving Wiesbaden Subject received a detailed briefing in countersurveillance techniques, which were emphasized during a walk through the business section of Wiesbaden. Missed contact arrangements caused cancellation of the planned live surveillance exercise.
- Subject's acceptance of the recruitment proposal in Wiesbaden seemed deliberate and sincere. However, before his planned first trip to Berlin Subject notified the writer that he had misgivings and that he could not go through with the scheduled turnover to a Berlin case officer. He said, however, that he was willing to discuss the reasons for his back-down.
- Accordingly, the writer visited Subject at his home on 4 December. Subject's backdown stemmed from a lessening in his motivation and also from a practical difficulty beyond his control. Affecting his motivation were "second thoughts" he had about the consequences to his wife his capture might have. He pointed out that already once in their lives - during World War II - they had been separated for nearly four years without knowing where the other was or even if he were alive. Subject is very close to his wife and together through very hard work they have built up a small business on which they are dependent for income and for security in their later years. He was troubled by the thought that through CATRANSIT he might be jeopardizing her future and their togetherness again without her knowledge and without her concurrence.

4. As Subject had not recently reassured on this point in Wiesbaden, no promises had been made to him regarding financial support of his wife in the event of his capture. He was now told that, in accepting his cooperation as a CATRANSIT, we would also be assuming his financial obligations to his wife and would fulfill these on his behalf, in the event of his arrest, until he were again in position to discharge them himself. This assurance seemed to lessen Subject's feeling that he was dealing behind her back in a matter which could have profound consequences for his wife. In a further attempt to prevent this feeling from being an obstacle to Subject's full recruitment, the writer offered to release Subject from his agreement - which he had honored - not to tell his wife of CATRANSIT and to discuss the whole matter in her presence that evening. Subject felt, however, that the reasons the writer had given in Wiesbaden for not making his wife willing still held and that, at least prior to his first trip to Berlin, he would continue to use the general cover story given her upon his return from Wiesbaden.

5. The practical difficulty preventing Subject's travelling soon to Berlin is the loss of a key employee in his business. Until she returns to work at the end of January he will have to take her place at the machines, as there is no replacement to be found. December and January are the peak months in Subject's business and consequently he will not have a weekend of sufficient length during this period to travel to Berlin. However, to give him an opportunity to test his resolve and competence in an enterprise so foreign to him, the writer arranged for Subject to fly to Frankfurt on 11 January for a day of counter-surveillance exercises. At the same time Subject should be able to make a firm date for his trip to Berlin.

6. Subject is a mature, intelligent, somewhat reticent person who, in spite of the setback on the first travel arrangements, is still judged to have the self-confidence and courage demanded by CATRANSIT. His war record as an officer in the Waffen SS Viking Division consists almost exclusively of combat service, during which he was wounded eight times. Since the war, except for a short period while he assembled the necessary capital, he has been in business for himself, a status he much prefers to that of a salaried employee. He can be expected to give his best during training sessions in Frankfurt and Berlin and, if these develop satisfactorily, to the mission itself.

Subject described his unsuccessful efforts to attract new employees and said he has little hope of finding any in the next few months. Given the fact that this situation has persisted now for six months, a further postponement of indefinite duration was unacceptable.</p> <p>2. Subject was not terminated, however, because his conversion into an accommodation address--a task compatible with his work demands--had the advantage of giving us some return on the investment made in him. It should be pointed out that security was not a factor in this decision for Subject has given us no reason to fear that, once terminated, he would abuse our confidence. The writer explained to Subject what work his service as an accommodation address would entail and the purpose and importance of this task. He agreed readily to perform this assignment in lieu of CATRANSIT.</p> <p>3. In view of Subject's location we are recommending him herewith to MOB as an accommodation address and are forwarding his file for your perusal. You will note that arrangements were made at the last meeting to permit an unassisted turn-over to another case officer. Nevertheless, the writer can make himself available to introduce the MOB case officer to Subject. If MOB should prefer, FOB would undertake to employ Subject directly as an accommodation address, in spite of the distance involved. We would welcome an early reply to this proposal.</p> <p>4.
