Mora has also advised that Mary Louise Camacho, nee Patterson, knew Oswald while he was in Russia. \* Greater detail from Mora on this point is extremely pertinent since CIA may have Camacho questioned in Russia about what she knows of Oswald and his activities while there \*\*(\*\*\*X\*\*\*)

Finally, Mora has furnished some information on Oswald's visit to the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City. We should determine all Mora knows about this visit and where she obtained her information.

This matter must be pursued in depth until we have fully explored and exhausted all of Mora's information. These questions, which the original information received from Mora hase raised, cannot be left unanswered and MEX-18 and MEX-19 (C) should be made fully aware of this. Of course, in receiving further information from Mora, care must be taken to distinguish that information which is speculation and belief on Mora's part from that which is factual.

Advise immediately whether MEX-18 and MEX-19 have recontacted Mora for the two or three-day period as planned if so, promptly furnish letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination.
