FBI Identification record reflects only one arrest, that in 1944. Chicago PD records negative. PD and court records reportedly destroyed by court order. Subject admittedly has been arrested numerous times but never convicted. Subject frequently questioned regarding killings in Chicago, suspected to have been of gang origin, and reportedly represented by syndicate lawyers who immediately obtained writ to effect his release. Associates reportedly are top echelon members of old Capone Chicago Crime Syndicate. Subject reportedly taking over duties of one such member, JAKE GUZIK, now deceased, as a syndicate gambling leader. Subject described as a syndicate man involved in operations of teamsters', taxi drivers' and bartenders' unions.
