LOCAL CONTENT

- Content related to a specific place, region, ethnical group, etc.
- It can be about local traditions, language, politics, social life, biographies, etc. related to a specific territory.
- In Wikimedia projects, local content can be archived in different ways:
 - Wikipedia: Either in the local language (if written) or any other language.
 - Commons: Audio, video and pictures of different events and occasions.
 - Wikidata: Great to archive information on people, monuments, places, etc.

CURRENT STATUS – AFRICAN CONTENT



Interest

- Low interest – Except from enthusiasts, militants or researchers.
- Post-colonial situation – adoration/complex towards the west
- Limited perspectives of career – work in the local context.

Social situation

- Priorities in life

Africa is not ruling the world (yet?)

- Editors outside of the continent will not write about it.

CURRENT STATUS – AFRICAN CONTENT

- Kabyle Wikipedia – 4275 articles
- 10 Most popular articles during October 2019
 - Only 2/10 are related to Kabyle/Berber context

 - Only 4/10 are related to Yoruba/Nigerian context

PARTICULARITIES OF AFRICA



Many official languages in Africa do not originate from the continent

- And yet they are the ones with most produced content in Africa!
- University studies are mostly in French/English and students tend to write in these languages.
- These languages have already their local/cultural contexts.

Some languages are spoken over different areas/countries

- Political/social tensions created between competing parts.

- Sustain already existing initiatives in your countries
 - Wiki Loves Monuments – Wiki Loves Earth – Festival documentation.
- Learn more about grants and how to ask for them.
- Involve more volunteers in your region.

SUGGESTIONS

- Identify your "champion" editors
 - University departments
 - Local Languages departments
 - African Studies departments (Worldwide)
 - Partner with local cultural associations – Ministry of culture.
- They already have motivation and knowledge.
 - They need only to know how to edit Wikipedia
