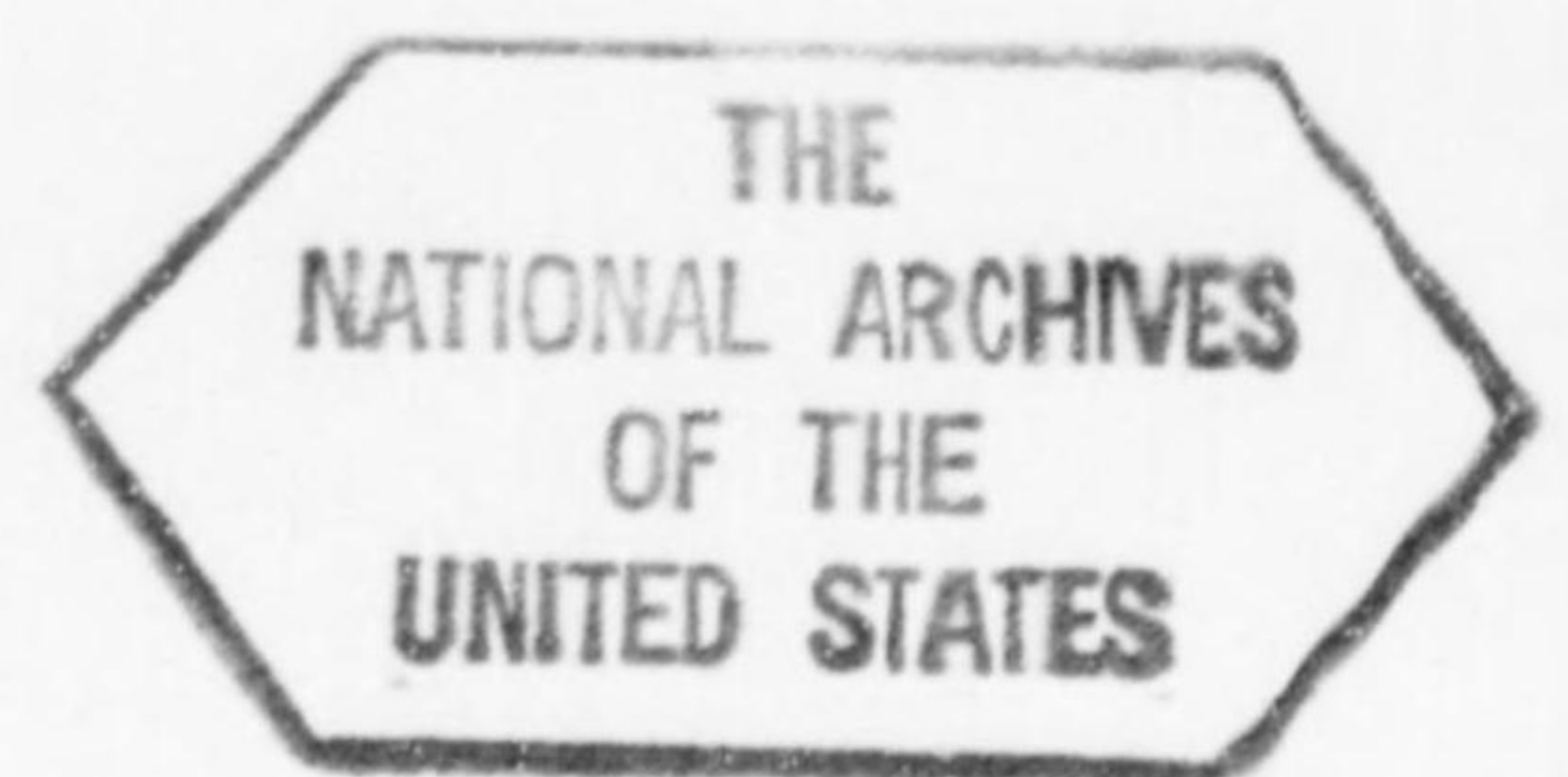

Subject: Request for the Consent of the Diet concerning the establishment of Branch Customs and Branch Offices under the Provisions of Article 156, Paragraph 4 of Local Autonomy Law.

In order to expect more smooth operation of various customs affairs coping with remarkable developments in the foreign trade, it is necessary that the Haneda Air Port Branch Office of Tokyo Branch Customs and the Tuzumi Branch Office of Hoji Custom-House will be raised respectively to the Status of Branch Customs, and in addition that Takashima Pier Branch Office of Yokohama Custom-House, Naka Pier Branch Office and Hyogo Pier Branch Office of Kobe Custom House and Yawata Branch Office of Kakumatsu Branch Customs and Harie Branch Office of Nagasaki Branch Customs will be newly established respectively. Reasons

Of the vessels for foreign route and aeroplanes entering and clearing Tokyo Harbour and Haneda Air-port, the vessels have been made to touch at Yokohama Harbour to be quarantined and the aeroplanes have been made to be quarantined by the competent personnel sent from Yokohama Quarantine Station, both due to the fact that no facilities for quarantine exists in Tokyo. But the recent increase in number of the vessels and aeroplanes entering and clearing there has reached the stage that allows no such temporary expedient measures, and, besides, with such measures, the chances for the aggression of virus are liable to increase; therefore, for the purpose of the completion of the prevention of communicable diseases, the establishment of the quarantine station has been required.
