



this means that decisions are made and action is taken by or as close as possible to the level of people affected by them








The Vehicle: Regional and Thematic Hubs

This means that there is democratic representation and participation in decisions that affect the whole movement and its parts








The Vehicle: A Global Body

You will elect somebody to represent your project, your affiliate or your community when big decisions about money, policies and technologies are being made.
















