Section I - Roster of Officer Personnel.

1. The following items will be checked for accuracy, corrected when in error, and inserted when missing:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROCESSING MACHINE RECORDS ROSTERS (cont'd)

2. Corrected roster will contain the names of all officers carried as assigned or attached on morning reports of the headquarters and sub-units of the organization. Incorrect sub-unit will be deleted and correct sub-unit entered without deleting or adding names. Roster strength will be in agreement by grade with strength of the corresponding morning report. In the event the strength section of a morning report for the last day of the month is incorrect, the roster will not be balanced to the morning report strength. The variance will be explained by entry of appropriate remarks on the roster authentication sheet.

3. No entry will appear in Column B, category, for Regular Army officers. Applicable category will be shown for officers who have signed a category statement under provisions of Circular 27, Department of the Army, 1948, as amended, i.e., 1, 2, 3, or 5. For officers who have not signed a category under the provisions of the above cited circular, the category signed under the provisions of Circular 366, War Department, 1945, as amended, will be shown, except category 1 officers will be shown as category 9.

a. Air Force Regulation 35-8, dated 9 April 1948, will govern Air Force personnel on extended active duty serving with the Army.

b. All non-RA WAC officers and WAC warrant officers who have not signed a category statement will be shown as category 9.

4. Entry under Column F, overseas service credit, will reflect the actual months of overseas service since 7 December 1941, or, overseas service credit computed in accordance with Circular 249, War Department 1947, as amended. Negative entries will be shown as "00" for no overseas service.

TO: Commanders of all agencies and organizations serviced by the 7th
Machine Records Unit, SAB, AGO.

1. Machine records rosters of officer and enlisted personnel are prepared monthly and forwarded to appropriate organizations for verification, correction of erroneous data, and entry of missing data. The cards from which these rosters are prepared comprise the basic machine records status file from which numerous reports are prepared for use of the Department of the Army. The accuracy of these reports is governed by the accuracy of corrected machine records rosters.
2. Rosters will be processed in accordance with the inclosed Instructions for Processing Machine Records Rosters.
3. In many cases, rosters are returned to this headquarters without being properly corrected in compliance with the inclosed instructions. Personnel officers, or those officers responsible for authentication of the rosters will insure that:
 - a. All data has been verified.
 - b. Erroneous information has been corrected.
 - c. Missing information entered.
 - d. Dates of morning reports on which the correct information has been, or will be reported.
4. The original and first two carbon copies (numbers 1, 2 and 3) of officer personnel rosters and the original and copy number 3 of the enlisted personnel roster will be processed without delay and will be dispatched to:



INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROCESSING MACHINE RECORDS ROSTERS (cont'd)

2. Corrected roster will contain names of all enlisted men carried as assigned on morning reports of the organization. Roster strength will be in agreement by grade with strength of corresponding morning reports. In the event the strength section of a morning report for the last day of the month is incorrect, the corresponding roster will be adjusted to reflect actual month-end strength. The variance will be explained by entry of appropriate remarks on the roster authentication sheet. Date of morning report which contains correction remarks necessary to effect an accurate strength balance will be shown.
3. Duty branch of enlisted personnel maintained in machine records files is not necessarily the arm or service for which enlisted. Generally, the duty branch of an individual will be the same as the arm or service of the organization to which assigned. If the organization to which an enlisted man is assigned has no arm or service, the duty branch of the individual will be based upon previous assignment, training, or choice of arm or service at the time of enlistment.
4. Enlisted men who are reflected in machine records files as being in an AWOL status as the effective date of the roster will be indicated by the letter "S" in Column A. Entries under this column will be added or deleted as appropriate. Total number of enlisted men shown as AWOL in the body of the roster will agree with the assigned AWOL strength shown on the morning report. For each enlisted man shown as AWOL on the corrected roster, date of absence will be entered in the MCO column. For individuals erroneously shown as AWOL, delete "S's" and enter appropriate remarks in MCO column to substantiate correction of AWOL status.
5. For each enlisted man whose term and date of enlistment indicate the individual would normally have been discharged prior to effective date of the roster, enter in MCO column remarks to justify retention in the service.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROCESSING MACHINE RECORDS ROSTER

Section III - Instructions Applicable for Both Officer and Enlisted Personnel Rosters.

1. Additions. All names will be listed at the bottom of the roster. Care will be taken to insure that names of officers added bear a basic status heading "assigned" or "attached from other organizations", as appropriate, and that sub-unit be shown.
2. Deletions will be made by drawing a single line through the name on all copies of the roster.
3. Corrections will be made by drawing a single line through the erroneous item and adding the correct data, legibly and accurately, on all copies of the roster.
4. Corrected roster will contain entries for all required items of information pertaining to assigned personnel. Where information cannot be determined from available records or by personal interviews, enter "UNK" (unknown). Number of "unknown" entries will be kept to a minimum. Data unknown when rosters are corrected will be obtained and reported by morning report remarks at the earliest practicable date.
5. Morning report entries are required for all additions, deletions, and corrections. In those cases where the required information was reported correctly on a morning report dated prior to the effective date of the roster, that date will be entered on the roster along side each addition, deletion or correction. In those cases where the required information was not reported correctly on a previous morning report, the date of the morning report on which the entries will be made will be entered along side each item necessary.

- 2 - United States Army - Regular Army (RA) - applies to that personnel who enlisted in the Regular Army for 21 months under provisions of Selective Service Act, 1948.
- 3 - Organized Reserve Corps (ORC-ERC) - applies to officer and enlisted personnel, male and female, of the Organized Reserve Corps on extended active duty. No Enlisted Reservist will be on active duty for more than 21 months.
- 4 - National Guard of the United States (NGUS) - applies to officer personnel of the National Guard of the United States and National Guard enlisted personnel on extended active duty for 21 months service under provisions of Selective Service Act, 1948.
- 5 - Philippine Scouts (PS) - applies to that personnel commissioned or enlisted in the Philippine Scouts who are United States citizens, by birth or naturalization (officers commissioned prior to December 1941 and enlisted personnel enlisted under provisions of Public Law 190 -- 79th Cong.; Bul. 19, 1945).
- N - Philippine Scouts (PS) - applies to that personnel commissioned or enlisted in the Philippine Scouts who are Philippine Nationals, citizens of the Commonwealth of the Philippines (officers commissioned prior to December 1941, and enlisted personnel enlisted under provisions of Public Law 190, 1945).
- 6 - Army of the United States (AUS) - applies to that personnel who enlist in the Army of the United States for a period of 12 months under provisions of Selective Service Act, 1948; enlisted personnel of the Women's Army Corps in the Army of the United States

2. Corrected roster will contain the names of all officers carried as assigned or attached on morning reports of the headquarters and sub-units of the organization. Incorrect sub-unit will be deleted and correct sub-unit entered without deleting or adding names. Roster strength will be in agreement by grade with strength of the corresponding morning report. In the event the strength section of a morning report for the last day of the month is incorrect, the roster will not be balanced to the morning report strength. The variance will be explained by entry of appropriate remarks on the roster authentication sheet.

3. No entry will appear in Column B, category, for Regular Army officers. Applicable category will be shown for officers who have signed a category statement under provisions of Circular 27, Department of the Army, 1948, as amended, i.e., 1, 2, 3 or 5. For officers who have not signed a category under the provisions of the above cited circular, the category signed under the provisions of Circular 366, War Department, 1945, as amended, will be shown, except category 1 officers will be shown as category 9.

a. Air Force Regulation 35-8, dated 9 April 1948, will govern Air Force personnel on extended active duty serving with the Army.

b. All non-RA WAC officers and WAC warrant officers who have not signed a category statement will be shown as category 9.

4. Entry under Column F, overseas service credit, will reflect the actual months of overseas service since 7 December 1941, or, overseas service credit computed in accordance with Circular 249, War Department 1947, as amended. Negative entries will be shown as "00" for no overseas service.

2. Corrected roster will contain names of all enlisted men carried as assigned on morning reports of the organization. Roster strength will be in agreement by grade with strength of corresponding morning reports. In the event the strength section of a morning report for the last day of the month is incorrect, the corresponding roster will be adjusted to reflect actual month-end strength. The variance will be explained by entry of appropriate remarks on the roster authentication sheet. Date of morning report which contains correction remarks necessary to effect an accurate strength balance will be shown.
3. Duty branch of enlisted personnel maintained in machine records files is not necessarily the arm or service for which enlisted. Generally, the duty branch of an individual will be the same as the arm or service of the organization to which assigned. If the organization to which an enlisted man is assigned has no arm or service, the duty branch of the individual will be based upon previous assignment, training, or choice of arm or service at the time of enlistment.
4. Enlisted men who are reflected in machine records files as being in an AWOL status as of the effective date of the roster will be indicated by the letter "S" in Column A. Entries under this column will be added or deleted as appropriate. Total number of enlisted men shown as AWOL in the body of the roster will agree with the assigned AWOL strength shown on the morning report. For each enlisted man shown as AWOL on the corrected roster, date of absence will be entered in the MCO column. For individuals erroneously shown as AWOL, delete "S's" and enter appropriate remarks in MCO column to substantiate correction of AWOL status.
5. For each enlisted man whose term and date of enlistment indicate the individual would normally have been discharged prior to effective date of the roster, enter in MCO column remarks to justify retention in the service.

Section III - Instructions Applicable to Both Officer and Enlisted Personnel Rosters.

1. Additions. All names will be listed at the bottom of the roster. Care will be taken to insure that names of officers added bear a basic status heading "assigned" or "attached from other organizations", as appropriate, and that sub-unit be shown.
2. Deletions will be made by drawing a single line through the name on all copies of the roster.
3. Corrections will be made by drawing a single line through the erroneous item and adding the correct data, legibly and accurately, on all copies of the roster.
4. Corrected roster will contain entries for all required items of information pertaining to assigned personnel. Where information cannot be determined from available records or by personal interviews, enter "UNK" (unknown). Number of "unknown" entries will be kept to a minimum. Data unknown when rosters are corrected will be obtained and reported by morning report remarks at the earliest practicable date.
5. Morning report entries are required for all additions, deletions, and corrections. In those cases where the required information was reported correctly on a morning report dated prior to the effective date of the roster, that date will be entered on the roster along side each addition, deletion or correction. In those cases where the required information was not reported correctly on a previous morning report, the date of the morning report on which the entries will be made will be entered along side each item necessary.


