

Matthew

10 And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. ² Now the names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; ³ Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James the son of Alphaeus, and ¹Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus; ⁴ Simon the Cananite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

⁵ These twelve Jesus sent out and commanded them, saying: *“Do not go into the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. ⁶ But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. ⁷ And as you go, preach, saying, ^j ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ ⁸ Heal the sick, ⁴ cleanse the lepers, ⁵ raise the dead, cast out demons. ^k Freely you have*

Mark 6:7-11 (NKJV)

⁷ And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, and gave them power over unclean spirits.

Luke 9:1-5 (NKJV)

⁹ Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. ² He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
