Labor Organization Registration Form

Public Law 101—80th Congress

To: Bureau of Labor Standards,
United States Department of Labor, Washington 25, D. C.

Section 9 (f) and (g) of the Labor Management Relations Act, 1947 (Public Law No. 101, 80th Congress, 1st sess.), requires that the following information be filed with the Secretary of Labor and kept up to date annually, before the National Labor Relations Board is authorized on petition or charge of a labor organization to take certain action in representation and unfair labor practice cases or in requests for election on a union shop.
