1. Yomiuri Saitama Section-C 27 Sept. Circ: 126,000

a. CITIZEN'S TAX PROBLEM EMBROILED CITY ASSEMBLY The discriminative taxation that the Omiya City Office applied a reduced rate of 15% in stead of 18% to citizen's tax to be paid by working people has been made a strong protest against by medium and small business men. The whole municipal assemblymen's council held to settle this problem on September 25 was adjourned. A rumor is afloated that Mayor's resignation may be brought about by this trouble.

2. Asahi Saitama Section-B 27 Sept. Circ: 97,000

a. BOVINE INFLUENZA RAMPANT The number of bovine influenza cases in this prefecture as of 26 September totaled 6318 with 130 dead showing a 4100 increase over that of the previous day.

b. ILLEGAL CORNERING OF TEXTILE The Gyoda City Police investigated 26 Sept. president Eiichi Suzuki of the Isami Socks Manufacturing Company, Gyoda City, on suspicion of having violated the Materials Adjustment Law and seized about 1,000 tan of cotton textile from the factory amounting to 10 million yen at blackmarket price which the suspected had cornered in anticipation of higher prices.

3. Yomiuri Saitama Section 29 Sept. Circ: 126,000

a. TROUBLE CAUSED BY EXCESS QUOTA DELIVERY OF RICE Pressed for money and in hopes of receiving cash reward, farmers in Towa-mura made haste in delivering rice. The food examining office, however, stopped examining rice delivered by them in excess of the quota owing to the shortage of incentive money. However, farmers are now in negotiation with the sub-prefectural local still wishing to receive the reward.

4. Asahi Saitama Section-B 30 Sept. Circ: 97,000

a. REVENUE OFFICERS' IRREGULARITY The Kumagaya Branch of the District Public Procurator's Office on 29 September investigated two tax collectors of the Musahi-Matsuyama Revenue Office who were suspected of having embezzled taxes collected amounting to more than ¥100,000.

5. Yomiuri Saitama Section-C 30 Sept. Circ: 126,000

a. DISTURBANCE OF COMMUNICATION 40 meters of the telegram wire under charge of the Nippatsu Company Wire Maintenance Agency in Sado-mura Minamisaitama-gun were stolen on 28 September.

1. Yomiuri Kanagawa 27 Sept. Circ: 180,000

a. CITIZEN'S CHURCH UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN YOKOSUKA Under the sponsorship of the Yokosuka Christianity Cooperation Association and with the support of the Yokosuka Naval Base Headquarters the Citizen's Church is now under construction at an estimated cost of 6 million yen.

2. Mainichi Kanagawa 28 September Circ: 173,000

a. LARGE-SCALE THEFT GANG OF TYPEWRITERS ARRESTED On 27 September the Kawasaki Police Station arrested a theft gang headed by Nobuyuki Ueno, Daishi Ueda-machi, Kawasaki City. They were rampant in the Keihin District Kanagawa and Saitama Prefectures specialized in the theft of typewriters, calculating machines and gasoline amounting to 10 million yen.

3. Mainichi Kanagawa 28 September Circ: 173,000

a. BOVINE INFLUENZA RAGING The number of Bovine Influenza cases in Naka County amounted to 1,000, dealing a serious blow to the production of milk.

4. Asahi Kanagawa (B) 28 September Circ: 170,000

a. SCHOOL CHILDREN PROHIBITED FROM PARTICIPATING IN COMMUNITY CHEST CAMPAIGN The prefectural Education Board has decided to prohibit primary school pupils and lower class students of lower secondary schools should from taking part in the campaign.

5. Yomiuri Kanagawa (A) 28 September Circ: 180,000

a. COMMUNITY CHEST CAMPAIGN The campaign is scheduled to be for one month beginning on 1 October to raise 50 million yen.

b. BARLEY DELIVERY The barley delivery in the prefecture showed 89.2% of the collection goal of 149,900 Koku as of September 25. Shimizu Village, Ashigarakami County has delivered 11% over its delivery quota.

 - a. BOVINE INFLUENZA RAMPANT The number of bovine influenza cases in Kitasoma, Sashima and Yuki counties in the prefecture amounted to 170 as of September 25.
2. Asahi Ibaraki Section 27 September 77,000 (Circ.)
 - a. ENFORCEMENT OF PERFECT SUPPLY OF SCHOOL LUNCH EXPECTED TO BE DIFFICULT The enforcement of complete supply of school lunch set for October 1 in the primary and lower secondary schools in Mito City is feared to be difficult because of the shortage of funds and heavy burden on parents.
3. Ibaraki Shinbun 27 September Circ:49,000 ST/ST
 - a. EXAMINATION OF UPLAND RICE BEGUN The Wakabe Food Agency on 25 September examined for the first time in this year 13 bales of upland rice delivered by farmers. The upland rice crop is said to be the largest since ~~1944~~ 1930.
 - b. BIG CATCH OF MACKEREL-PIKE The Daisen Maru (83 tons) on 26 September came back to the Nakaminato Port with 8,000 kan of mackerel-pike. Other ships are expected to return soon with a big catch to various ports in the prefecture.
 - c. PURGE OF OBSCENE MAGAZINES At the Nishi Ibaraki County Women's Associations Liaison Committee meeting held on 23 September at Iwama Town the prevention of abstention from voting in the Education Board election, purge of obscene magazines and imperfect polishing of rice were discussed.
4. Ibaraki Shinbun 28 September Circ:49,000 ST/KN
 - a. ROUND-UP OF ILLEGAL HOLDERS OF FIREARMS AND SWORDS The Mito-kaido Police arrested Masao Ogawa and nine other persons by September 26 for illegally holding firearms or swords.

a. RICE AND SWEET POTATO CROP ESTIMATED A LITTLE ABOVE NORMAL The Agriculture-Forestry Ministry revealed on 27 September that this year's rice and sweet potato crops will be a little higher than the average year despite the extensive damage caused by the last typhoons.

b. TWO NATIONAL RAILWAY CORPORATION WORKERS ARRESTED The Kumagaya Municipal Police Station apprehended two railway workers of the Omiya Railway Station for stealing three baggages of cotton socks from a freight-car just leaving the station on 27 September.

2. Asahi Shinbun (YUKAN) 28 September Circ:200,000

a. EIGHT HOSPITALS FORM JOINT PHARMACY With the expected separation of medicine and pharmacy looming ahead, eight practitioners in the vicinity of Akabane have opened a new joint pharmacy with a capital of ¥700,000. They are expected to establish a health center for examining patients in the pharmacy.

3. Mainichi Shinbun 28 September Circ:432,000

a. COTTON TO BE DECONTROLLED Chief Kondo of the Textile Board of the International Trade and Industry Ministry has revealed that the control on cotton goods will be lifted in the near future.

4. Asahi Shinbun 28 September Circ:413,000

a. LEADER OF SWINDLERS ARRESTED On 27 September, the Otsuka Police arrested broker Yoshiro Ishizaka on the charge of swindle. He is the ringleader of a swindlers' group who have swindled more than ¥ 10 million by using false 1,000-yen-bank-notes.

b. PAYMENT OF FIXED ASSETS TAX SLUGGISH About 2.2 billion yen of the Metropolitan fixed assets tax for the first term of this year is in arrears with the collection rate of 56.3 % as of 25 September, the Metropolitan Revenue Department announced.
