## 1. 1. References:

- a. Memorandum, G2 to Chief of Staff, dated 9 Sep 51, subject: "Eighth Army Request for MIS Platoon." (Incl 1)
  - b. Letter, G2, Eighth Army to G2, FEC, file KGI, dated 9 Dec 51, subject: "Additional MIS Platoon." (Incl 2)
  - c. Msg, XVI Corps to CINCPAC, GX 50694 RCGI, dated 12 Jan 52. (Incl 3)
2. Reference 1a above (approved by CofS, 10 Sep 51) outlined the following:
- a. Eighth Army request for representation to British Govt to obtain intelligence specialists for British Commonwealth Division and that 330th or 340th MIS Platoon be sent to Korea as an interim measure.
  - b. British Commonwealth reply stating it considered that intelligence organization in Korea should not be divided and that US personnel should be used.
  - c. Inspections of the 330th and 340th MIS Platoons during 29 Aug - 2 Sep 51 indicated units were not ready for service in Korea. Further intensive training for 60-90 days was recommended.
3. On 9 Dec 51, G2, Eighth Army requested that the 330th MIS Platoon be assigned to Eighth Army to furnish additional intelligence support to British Commonwealth Division and I ROK Corps (ref 1b). However, both 330th and 340th MIS Platoons were still undergoing training at that time and no formal action to move either platoon was taken.

4. Reference 1c above stated that inspection on 9 Jan 52 disclosed much improvement in state of training of both units and recommended both platoons be sent to Korea for on-the-job training, indicating XVI Corps has no requirement for either of the subject units.

5. G2 is presently conducting limited operations at the FEC Intelligence School at Camp Palmer with a skeleton force of administrative and instructional personnel borrowed from other G2 units. A T/D augmentation to MISG/FE, 8238th AU, which will consist of approximately 30 Officer and 35 EM and/or DAC spaces, is being prepared to provide the school with adequate administrative and instructional personnel for an expanded curriculum and student body -- an increase of approximately ten (10) Officers and twenty (20) EM and/or DACs over its present strength. G2 believes that the 340th MIS Platoon, consisting of eight (8)

(cont) Officer and twenty (20) EM spaces, could, due to its cellular structure, be gainfully utilized by FEC Intelligence School to help fill the above requirements while receiving valuable on-the-job training and at the same time constitute a trained Military Intelligence Service unit in GHQ Reserve. Unit integrity would be maintained and the organization would be kept ready for immediate use in the field.

## 6. It is accordingly recommended that:

a. The 330th MIS Platoon, at present levels of personnel and equipment, be alerted for shipment to Eighth Army, readiness date to be thirty (30) days from date of approval.

b. The 340th MIS Platoon, at present levels of personnel and equipment, be alerted for shipment to MISG/FE, 8238th AU, for duty with FEC Intelligence School. Readiness date to be fifteen (15) days from date of approval.

c. G3 prepare and issue necessary movement orders in connection with the movement of the 330th and 340th MIS Platoons as shown in par 6a and b above, with necessary adjustment of troop spaces between commands.

MEMORANDUM TO: Chief of Staff

SUBJECT: Eighth Army Request for MIS Platoon

1. On 15 Aug 51, Eighth Army requested by radio (Incl 1) that representation be made to the British government to obtain appropriate intelligence specialists for the 1st British Commonwealth Division. At the same time, it was requested that either the 330th or the 340th MIS Platoon be sent to Korea as an interim measure.

2. Upon receipt of the foregoing request, G2 recommended:

a. That Chief, UNC Liaison Section, GHQ, request the British government to provide the desired intelligence support for the 1st British Commonwealth Division.

b. That CG, XVI Corps, be directed to conduct a training inspection of subject platoons and to recommend one unit for service in Korea:

- (1) With the 1st British Commonwealth Division
- (2) With a US Corps.

These recommendations received Chief of Staff approval on 22 Aug 51, and were implemented by Incls 2 and 3.

3. Request was made to British Commonwealth on 25 Aug 51, and a reply dated 31 Aug 51 (Incl 4) was received to the effect that it was not considered desirable that there be any division in the intelligence organization providing for current requirements in Korea, and that it was felt that US intelligence personnel should handle the entire problem. It was further stated that a group of intelligence personnel similar to that provided in a US division would be appreciated for the 1st British Commonwealth Division.

4. Inspections of the 340th and 330th MIS Platoon were conducted 29-30 Aug and 1-2 Sep 51, respectively, and three officers of G2, GHQ, observed both. As a result of these inspections, CG, XVI Corps, reported (Incl 5) that since both platoons were losing about 50% of their personnel (ERC) by 30 Sep 51, and since the residual personnel lacked the necessary qualifications, neither platoon was considered capable of performing either mission outlined in 2 b, above. The 330th MIS Platoon was nominated. However, it was recommended that both platoons be given 60-90 days' intensive training in Japan after receiving fillers prior to commitment. G2, GHQ, concurs. Detailed report of inspection has not yet been received, but personnel of this section are familiar with its content.

5. Upon receipt of the information contained in pars 3 and 4 above, coordination was effected with the Acting G2, Eighth Army (Col Williams) and the situation was explained. Col Williams agreed that the time required to bring one of these units up to desired operating efficiency would be the same regardless of where the training took place, and therefore concurred in conducting it in Japan. He stated that Eighth Army could meet the requirements of the 1st British Commonwealth Division for the time being, and was informed that if additional spaces were required to furnish a normal US Division language detachment for 1st British Commonwealth Division, they should be requested through normal channels, unless one of subject platoons (with spaces) was later assigned to EUSAK regardless of British Commonwealth recommendations.

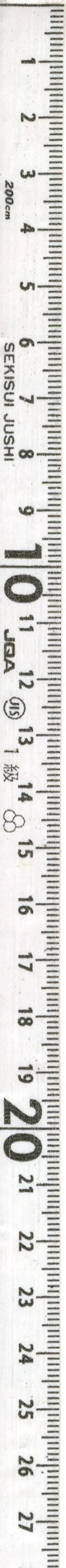

SUBJECT: Movement Orders No. 1

TO: Commanding Officer  
4th Mobile Radio Broadcasting Co

1. Pursuant to authority contained in message CX 61703, GHQ, FEC, dated 17 January 1952, it is directed that the CO, 4th Mobile Radio Broadcasting Co. take the necessary action to prepare for movement and move his unit and personnel and equipment (less program detachment to remain in Japan) to Korea. Location in Korea will be as designated by CG, Eighth Army.

2. Change of Station.

- a. This is a permanent change of station.
- b. Effective upon arrival in Korea the 4th Mobile Broadcasting Co is attached to Eighth Army for logistical support.
- c. Unit remains assigned to Hq & Sv Comd under operational control of 1st Radio Broadcasting & Leaflet Gp, GHQ, FEC.

3. Method and Date of Movement.

- a. Unit will move by air, rail and/or water transportation at the earliest practicable date.
- b. Shipping number 40605 is assigned this movement.

4. Other instructions.

a. The provisions of letter, Hq, Eighth Army, file AGGP, subject: "Procedures Governing the Preparation and Movement of Units to Korea", dated 21 Aug 50, will be strictly complied with.

b. Unit will move with present equipment.

c. Immunization records will be checked prior to departure for Korea to insure compliance with the following criteria:
