


In November, 2020, 4.9% of pageviews were "automated". There were 17.0B "user"-only pageviews.

Key trends

- YoY increase in total pageviews and content interactions persisted in November.
- The increase in pageviews was driven by an overall 11% YoY increase in English and Spanish Wikipedia, from external search engine and internal referral.
- The desktop previews continued to grow YoY. The growth was most prominent in English, Germany and Japanese Wikipedia.
- Consistent with the spikes we saw in overall traffic, unique devices increased YoY across countries.

On 29 April 2020, Analytics Engineering implemented new bot detection to identify previously-unidentified bots as "automated" agents. For consistency in reporting with prior years' metrics, we will include "automated" agents in our high-level reporting through the end of FY20-21. See Wikitech for details about bot detection.




Key trends

- Overall active editors continued its growth in November, with a 6.9% YoY increase.
- The clearest growth in new active editors was happening at pt.wiki, fa.wiki, Commons and Wikidata.
- Steady growth in returning active editors seems to be taking place in Commons, wikidata, pt.wiki, and fa.wiki from users registered between 30 to 90 days
- New editor retention was slightly higher in November, the growth was mainly from French, Germany, Arabic Wikipedia and Commons.


Wikimedia Active Editors year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020



Key trends


- Last month, the changes in net new content metrics are primarily because of bots: the large decrease in net new Wikidata entities was from ~2M drop in content created by bots.
- After removing Wikidata, in Commons files, we were seeing ~400K more files created by bots. In addition, there was ~90K new Wikipedia articles created by bots from tt.wiki, arz.wiki, ce.wiki and ceb.wiki.
- There were drop in bot edits across multiple projects. After removing bot edits, we continued to see increase in non-bot edits from users registered over 10 years from en.wiki and fr.wiki.


Wikimedia Net New Content year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020



Wikimedia Net New Content (non-Wikidata) year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020




Wikimedia Net New Wikipedia Articles year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020




Wikimedia Net New Common Content year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020






Wikimedia Revert Rate year-over-year comparison July 2018 - November 2020
