

Union Nov 29th 1828

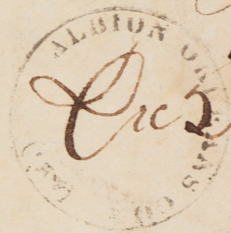
Respected friend,

Thy letter in answer

to which I cannot do otherwise than
say as I did before that I am
wholly destitute of means until I
can sell either my store or the farm
which I mentioned before —
I feel some in hopes that I can
make sale for it in N. Jersey if not
here — I shall leave it for sale and
be assured that my object is wholly to
pay my debts — I some expect to
start on my journey tomorrow or
next day — I would sell my store
very low for good pay, yet not be
cause I consider it poor property
but I think it would be better for me
to sell it than keep it —
