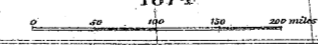






MAP OF THE UNITED STATES

Conservator's Report  
Bentley Historical Library

Title: Lapeer County - 1874

Remarks: Book bound in case-style binding. Cover was of cloth. Binding had been repaired previously. Joints were shaken. Boards were loose. Book was side-sewn by hand. Sewing was sound. Paper was acidic and brittle. Pages had previously been laminated with mulberry tissue adhered with wheat paste, which obscured the text to some extent. Boards were of solid binder's board.

Treatment: Picked book to pieces. Washed pages in water removing previous lamination. Deacidified. Laminated. Added new endsheets. Rebound in new scrapbook-style binding with a cloth cover.

Materials: Filtered water. Weibull's deacidification solution. Jade #834-403N PVA adhesive. PROMATCO heavy-duty endsheet paper. Adesco cork tissue. Davcy "Red Label" binder's board. Pyroxylin-impregnated library buckram. 23K gold.
