

05 June 2013: Central Europe – Floods

GERMANY



- **3 people killed**
- Situation along Danube, critical but stable
- Levels still rising in Elbe, peak of the flood wave from Czech Republic is still expected in Sachsen and Sachsen-Anhalt.
- Preparations under way in Brandenburg, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Niedersachsen.
- 9,000 people evacuated in Bavaria, 10,000 in Sachsen, 2,000 in Sachsen Anhalt and 3,200 in Thuringia, and many towns still under water in these regions.
- Media reported: emergency alert in place in Regensburg; Deggendorf completely cut-off.
- Passau: situation is slightly improving, water is reported still high in the streets.
- Evacuations (notably) in Bitterfeld and Dresden. Meissen old town under water.

CZECH REPUBLIC



- **8 people killed**
- In total, ca. 20,000 people evacuated (>10,500 in Ústecký)
- 3rd level flood activity in Středočeský, Jihočeský, Plzeňský and Prague
- Prague: Vltava decreasing; some underground stations reopened
- In Ústecký the levels of the Elbe were still rising as of early on 5 June
- Cidlina river still rising in area above Melník (Ústecký). Melník evacuated
- In Jihočeský, 97 villages still in state of emergency; problems with potable water supplies. Lužnice and Nežárka rivers expected to rise today. Decrease of water levels for all other rivers

SLOVAKIA



- Bratislava region: severe river floods (especially in areas around Bratislava, rivers Danube and Morava).
- Slovak Hydrometeorological Institute (SHMI) declared an emergency for Bratislava, Nitra and Trnava region (located in the basin of Danube and Morava rivers). Water levels are still rising.

AUSTRIA



- **2 people killed, 2 missing**
- Situation in Vorarlberg, Tyrol and Salzburg is improving.
- Operational focus currently on Danube (Oberosterreich & Niederosterreich); local evacuations.
- Rivers Inn and Enns are declining, also River Danube in Oberosterreich.
- Transportation networks still affected in parts of Tirol, Salzburg, Oberosterreich & Niederosterreich.

HUNGARY

- State of Emergency declared in Győr-Moson-Sopron, Komárom-Esztergom, Pest and Budapest.
- Flood expected to reach Budapest on 9 June, preparations under way.
- Ca. 100 people preventively evacuated from 3 municipalities in these regions as of early on 5 June.
