THE WEBB PRIZE

The annual Webb Prize of Three Hundred Dollars was instituted in 1887 by Dr. W. Seward Webb, of New York, to be awarded during the lifetime of the founder to the best landscape in the exhibition, painted by an American artist under forty years of age. The award to be made by the Jury of each annual Exhibition. The award not to be given to the same artist a second time.

This year (1901) the limitation of age has been removed, and Marines are included among the eligible paintings.

THE SHAW FUND

The Shaw Fund of Fifteen Hundred Dollars was devoted to the purchase of a composition painted in oil by an American artist, containing one or more figures, to be selected by the Jury from the works in the annual Exhibition. The picture thus chosen became the property of Samuel T. Shaw, Esq., the donor of the fund.

THE SHAW PRIZE

The Shaw Fund has been withdrawn, and in its place Mr. Shaw has founded the Shaw Prize of Three Hundred Dollars which is to be given annually for the best figure composition in the Exhibition, painted in oil by an American citizen and the property of the painter, portraits to be excluded. The prize will be given by a vote of all the members of the Society present on Varnishing Day, a plurality vote to decide the award. The same artist may not receive the prize in two successive years, and not more than twice in all. The founder of the prize reserves an option for three days after the announcement of the award for the purchase of the prize picture at the listed price.

THE CARNEGIE PRIZE

An annual prize of Five Hundred Dollars has been instituted by Mr. Andrew Carnegie, and will be awarded by the Jury for the most meritorious oil painting in the Exhibition by an American artist, portraits only excepted, the picture to be the property of the artist. The same artist may not receive the prize in two successive years, and not more than twice in all. The founder of the prize reserves an option for two days after the announcement of the award for the purchase of the prize picture at the listed price.
