

SITUATION

- Severe weather conditions (rain, winds, thunderstorms) continue to affect several parts of Europe, causing floods.
 As of 3 June, several Meteo Alarm -Orange Alerts are still in effect in Europe (see map).
- In **France**, heavy rain and thunderstorms, affected several parts of the country, causing the death of three people, injuring over 11 and damaged over 350 homes.
- In Germany, severe weather also affected several parts of the country, causing the death of six people, injuring at least 30 and damaging over 500 homes.
- In **Belgium**, heavy rain caused the evacuation of several people mostly in the eastern areas of the country.
- In **Austria**, one person died due to lightning, as of 3 June.
