Dear Sir:

It is common knowledge that there have been many changes in forest names, transfers, abolishments, combinations, absorptions, etc., during the history of the Forest Service. It is not unusual for this office to have occasion to answer inquiries referring to a national forest which no longer exists under a given name or as a separate entity. No doubt similar inquiries are received in field offices. Over a period of more than fifty years the changes have been so numerous that it is difficult, if not impossible, for forest officers to readily identify forests which have long since disappeared officially. To our knowledge, no single source for reference has been available.

Attached is an alphabetical list of the names of all national forests which have existed officially in the life of the Forest Service. This tabulation further cites the official action by which those forests which did not exist as of June 1, 1957 lost their identity.

It is hoped that this list will be of value for your reference.
