



# Wikidata

- Started in 2012
- Free, open, linked, **structured, collaborative and multilingual** knowledge base
- From multi-(sub)domain multilingual Wikipedia sites to a single-domain multilingual website

**LGBT** is an initialism that stands for "lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender." In use since the 1990s, the initialism, as well as some of its common variants, functions as an umbrella term for certain sexualities and gender identities.<sup>[1]</sup>

The LGBT term is an adaptation of the initialism **LGB**, which began to replace the term *gay* (or *gay and lesbian*) in reference to the broader [LGBT community](#) beginning in the mid-to-late 1980s.<sup>[2]</sup> When not inclusive of transgender people, the shorter term LGB is still used instead of LGBT.<sup>[3][4]</sup>

It may refer to anyone who is [non-heterosexual](#) or [non-cisgender](#), instead of exclusively to people who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender.<sup>[5]</sup> To recognize this inclusion, a popular variant, **LGBTQ**, adds the letter *Q* for those who identify as [queer](#) or are [questioning](#) their sexual or [gender identity](#).<sup>[6]</sup> The initialisms *LGBT* or *GLBT* are not agreed to by everyone that they are supposed to include.<sup>[7]</sup>






