SUBJECT: Movement of Reparation Machinery

TO : Lt. Col. Russell G. Rehkop, Commanding Officer  
Hyogo Military Government Team

1. Permission is hereby sought for movement of machine-tools, listed below, from our Takasago Factory to our Nishinomiya Factory to be used for 192nd Ordnance Battalion, U.S. Army. These machine-tools constitute a part of machinery which were formerly installed in our Nishinomiya Factory, but were latterly moved to our Takasago Factory for storage pending removal as reparation materials.

2. Purposes of Using Repairs of buildings and equipment such as boiler, water pump, drain, electric and heating systems, and manufacture of equipment parts and accessories, as our maintenance service.

3. Place of Installing A warehouse erected at Northern part of Factory area.

4. Maintenance Every care will be excercized for maintenare of machine-tools, and they will be repaired and serviced at all times, as and when necessary, to keep them in good condition. Also, all regulations governing reparation materials will be strictly observed, and machine-tools will be moved to specified places in case of removal for reparation purposes.

5. Means of Transportation Train or cargo trucks will be used for transportation of machine-tools, and every care will be excercized to keep them from damage during transportation.
