1. Linguists to fulfill requirements as indicated in basic communication are not available in the Far East Command.

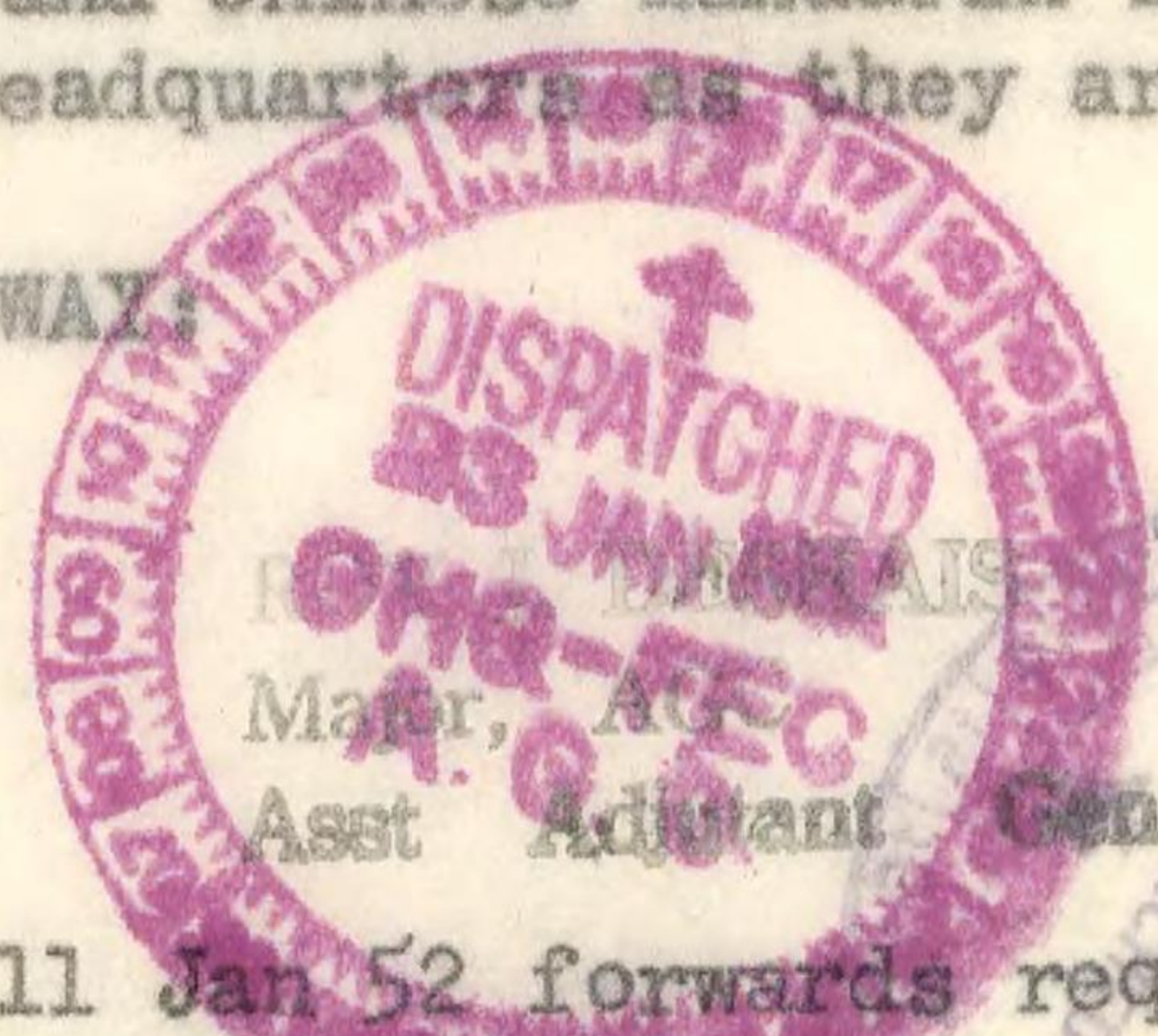
2. Special requisitions to Department of Army from this headquarters for Korean and Chinese Mandarin linguists were placed as early as 29 Jun 50 for Korean and 4 Aug 50 for Chinese Mandarin. Continuing requisitions and estimated forecasts for linguist requirements in FEC which included the numbers indicated in basic communication were made in Sep 50, Oct 50, Jun 51 and as late as Oct 51. A separate letter to Department of Army, 26 Jun 51, regarding Chinese and Korean linguists directed special attention to Eighth Army requirements in these languages.

3. Department of the Army radio 11 Nov 51 advised this command that it is doubtful that our requirements for Chinese and Korean military linguists will be filled in the near future; however, quotas at the Army Language School have been increased in order to alleviate the situation.

4. The lack of military and Chinese Mandarin linguists has required units of this headquarters as well as Eighth Army to make maximum utilization of DAC and indigenous linguists, an expedient which of necessity must continue until military linguists are trained and become available.

5. A revision of current FEC linguist requirements and future estimates is being prepared for forwarding to Department of the Army, and Eighth Army requirements, as enumerated in basic communication, are again being included. Advice regarding arrival of Korean and Chinese Mandarin linguists for your command will be forwarded to your Headquarters as they arrive in FEC.

Basic communication EUSAK ltr 11 Jan 52 forwards requisition for Eighth Army linguist requirements indicating 20 each Korean and Chinese Mandarin company grade officers, 80 Korean and 85 Chinese Mandarin enlisted.

DA radio DA 86753, 11 Nov 51, indicates additional quotas at the ALS have been requested to fulfill FEC requirements; however, it is difficult to estimate the availability of linguists at this time. 1. Linguists to fulfill requirements as indicated in basic communication are not available in the Far East Command.

2. Special requisitions to Department of Army from this headquarters for Korean and Chinese Mandarin linguists were placed as early as 29 Jun 50 for Korea and 1 Aug 50 for Chinese Mandarin. Continuing requisitions and estimated forecasts for linguist requirements in FEC which included the numbers indicated in basic communication were made in Sep 50, Oct 50, Jan 51 and as late as Oct 51. A separate letter to Department of Army, 26 Jun 51, regarding Chinese and Korean linguists directed special attention to Eighth Army requirements in these languages.

3. Department of the Army radio 11 Nov 51 advised this command that it is doubtful that our requirements for Chinese and Korean military linguists will be filled in the near future; however, quotas at the Army Language School have been increased in order to alleviate the situation.

4. The lack of military and Chinese Mandarin linguists has required units of this headquarters as well as Eighth Army to make maximum utilization of DAG and indigenous linguists, an expedient which of necessity must continue until military linguists are trained and become available.

5. A revision of current FEC linguist requirements and future estimates is being prepared for forwarding to Department of the Army, and Eighth Army requirements as enumerated in basic communication, are again being included. Advice regarding arrival of Korean and Chinese Mandarin linguists for your command will be forwarded to your Headquarters as they arrive in FEC.

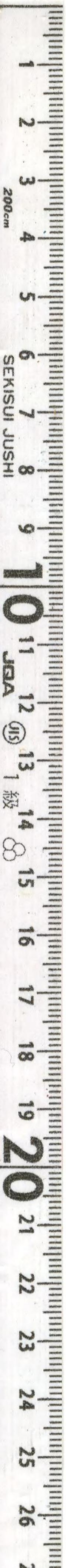
Basic communication EUSAK 14r 11 Jan 52 forwarded requisition for Eighth Army linguist requirements indicating 20 Chinese and Chinese Mandarin company grade officers, 80 Korean and 82 Chinese Mandarin enlisted. DA radio DA 86753, 11 Nov 51, indicates additional quotas at the ALS have been requested to fulfill FEC requirements; however, it is difficult to estimate the availability of linguists at this time. Further indicates Korean and Chinese Mandarin linguists are extremely rare. Balance self-explanatory.

2. Experience derived from the past two operations indicates that the project will be one entailing all night work. We have re-aligned our personnel, therefore, into two definite shifts in order not to impose an undue hardship on any one individual. It is felt that by operating alternately with these shifts, the daily operations of the various G2 sections will not be disrupted too much and the burden will not be too great on any one person.

Om #1 3. Past operations indicate that in order to process the communications as expeditiously as is desired by the General, a team of eight (8) typists is necessary for each shift. Such a team was operative on the night of 31 Dec - 1 Jan and proved to be a very satisfactory arrangement.

4. If those individuals noted in par 1 can be depended upon in the future to work at the time deemed necessary by us, we require four (4) additional typists in order to operate as indicated in pars 2 and 3 above; if those individuals cannot be relied on, we need eight (8) additional typists available at our call.

5. Request that four (4) officers, in addition to those already so earmarked, be made available to us for the operation.
