In addition to the above five plants, Matsushita had an Electric Refining Company at SUZOKI, SHIKOKU which manufactured electrolytic manganese. Conduit tubes were also made by Matsusjita manufactured at a plant in Kadoma (Osaka area)

Prior to the war Matsushita manufactured ordinary electrical appliances such as flat irons, radios, lamps, etc.

They did not become engaged in war work until the end of 1942 and then only to a small degree. Their first large scale conversion to Wartime manufacture took place in 1943. Matsushita was also engaged in the manufacture of wooden ships, bombs etc.

This company also has another division devoted to the manufacture of machine tools, lathes, grinders, drill presses and the like. A machine tool questionnaire will be submitted to this office 5 November 1945.

They will prepare statistics and answers to the Electrical questionnaire for each of their five electrical equipment plants and will forward same to reach this office 5

November 1945.
