YAMAGATANITO AIRFIELD

This airfield was primarily a training base. All planes observed were primary trainers.

The remains of one training device intended to give the sensation of flying was observed.

The two hangers had been recently removed, probably by the Japanese for the lumber.

The position of the airfield in the bed of the river made it seem probable, that it was not usable during certain seasons of the year.

Additional dispersal areas were located in the fields to the south of the airfield.

All reports previously written, were found to be correct in every detail.

There were no anti-aircraft defenses.
