- 1. In view of the very practical and realistic problems with which the Ministry of Telecommunications is confronted in its efforts to provide essential telephone installations and services for business and residential users in the congested areas of Japan and particularly in the cities of Tokyo and Osaka, where approximately one hundred new buildings are under construction, CCS does not interpose any objections to the introduction of the subject bill in the Diet.
- 2. The proposed method of financing plant expansion is acceptable in Japan on historical grounds since it comports with past practices and traditions, however, since fiscal and economic policies appear to be concerned it is suggested that ESS comment on the latter matters for the benefit of Government Section.

- 1. It is recommended that clearance of the attached bill, Bill for Temporary Measures for the Charge of Cost of Telephone Installation, be withheld. Trom clearnice.
- 2. Purpose of subject bill is to provide a source of funds to be used to finance an increase in the capital program of the telecommunications enterprise. Economic conditions over the past several months, however, have given rise to scarcities of raw materials and to price increases in Japan out of all proportion to increases in world prices. These conditions have now developed to a point where expension of capital construction programs with the resultant increased demand for critical items cannot be permitted if inflationary pressures are to be held within bounds. This position is especially applicable to the capital program of the telecommunications enterprise which demands non-ferrous metals and other items, the supply of which is even more critical and for which price increases have been even greater than for other items in short supply.
- 3. Furthermore, the proposal consists effectively of a forced borrowing from the subscriber. Additional borrowing by the Japanese Government to expand its' capital programs has been consistently rejected as a violation of the stabilization directive.
