## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol to honor the last surviving Medal of Honor recipient of the Second World War upon death.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. HONORING LAST SURVIVING MEDAL OF HONOR**  
4 **RECIPIENT OF SECOND WORLD WAR.**

5        (a) USE OF ROTUNDA.—At the election of the indi-  
6 vidual (or next of kin of the individual), the last individual  
7 to die who was awarded the Medal of Honor for acts per-  
8 formed during World War II shall be permitted to lie in  
9 honor in the rotunda of the Capitol upon death.

1           (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Architect of the Capitol,  
2 under the direction and supervision of the President pro  
3 tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
4 Representatives, shall take the necessary steps to imple-  
5 ment subsection (a) upon the death of the individual de-  
6 scribed in such subsection.
