

Rakhine state

- 402 000 people including 120 000 Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) and 20 000 “returnees” need humanitarian assistance
- 1 200 000 people (mostly Rohingya) suffer from institutional discrimination, disenfranchisement and deprivation, including lack of access to citizenship
- In northern Rakhine, 90% of the population suffer from malnutrition

Kachin and Shan States

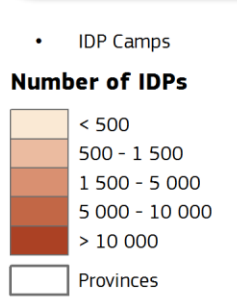
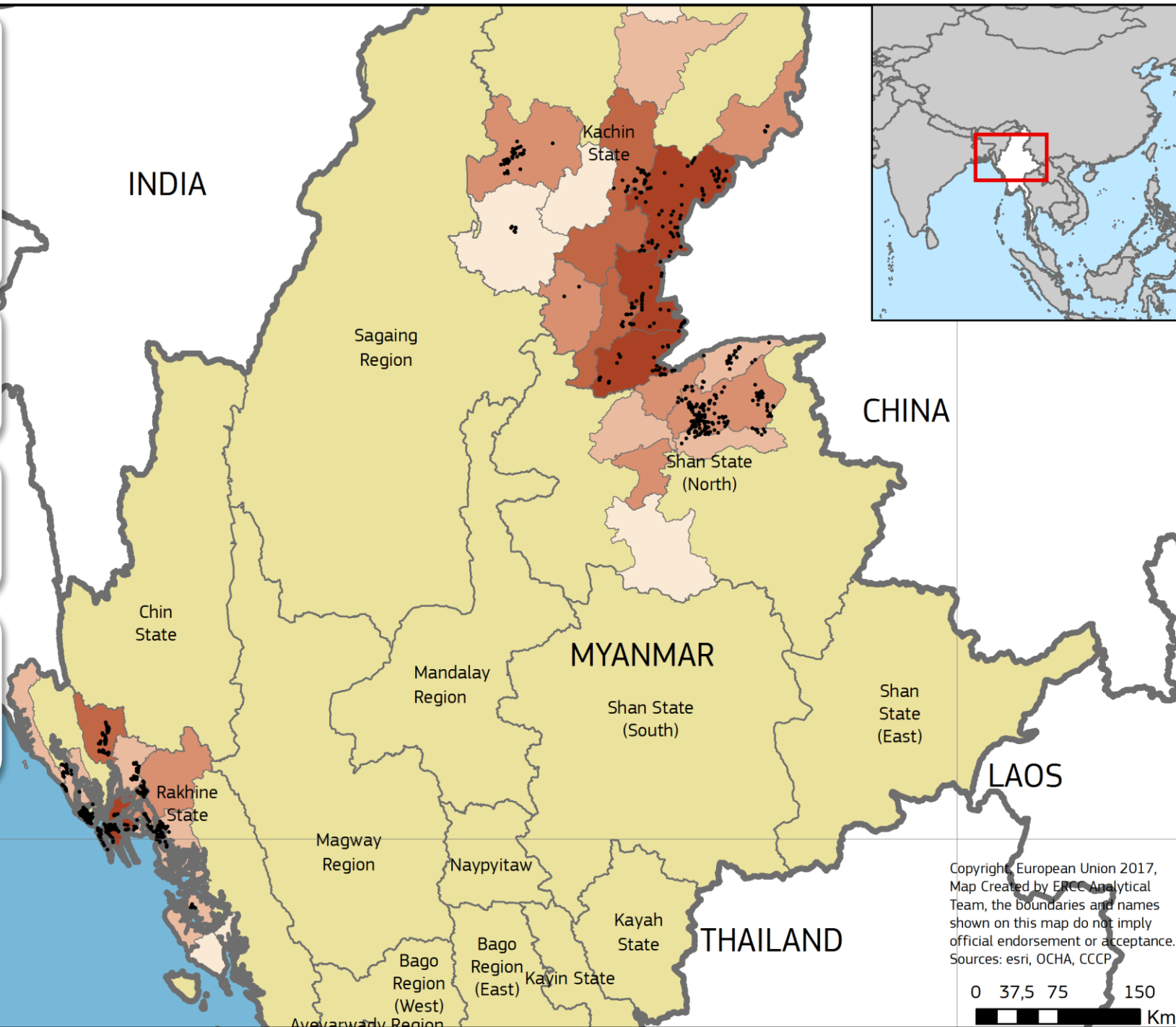
- 104 000 people including 87 000 IDPs in Kachin and 11 000 IDPs in Shan need humanitarian assistance due to armed conflict

Refugees in the Thai Myanmar Border Area

- 102 000 Myanmar Refugees living in 9 camps on the Myanmar-Thai Border

Natural Disasters

- Myanmar is one of the most disaster prone countries in Asia.
- The most common disasters are cyclones, storms, floods, landslides, earthquakes, tsunamis, drought and fire.
