The files contain voluminous information concerning one Dr. (lawyer) Joachim DAEUMLING (alias DEUMLING, Hamel DAUMLING) born 1910, Begerhof Germany, Advisor to Egyptian Army Intelligence Directory in 1954, who is believed to be identifiable with the subject of your request. A summation of the information is as follows.

HA.



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

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
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candidates as agents, that these people received special training and were then flown to IRAQ or PERSIA. MERZ heard that a short time before he arrived back in BEHLIN, a group of four AMT VI agents had been transported to PERSIA with the mission to blow up a large railway tunnel and thus to interrupt the flow of war materials to RUSSIA by this route. MERZ was unable to state exactly which tunnel was meant but it was supposed to be at a bottle-neck and the only tunnel which, if blown up, would effectively stop traffic for a considerable period.

(Note by I.C.: MERZ volunteered this information. He had not been given any hint that the British knew of the existence of such AMT VI missions. His statement probably refers to "FRANZ" Expedition which joined FRANZ MAYR in TEHRAN. This party consisted of six men, four so-called "SD" agents (one of them definitely a former SS officer) and two ABWEHR men. This group arrived in PERSIA in April 1943. It is interesting to note that in AMT VI there seems to have been no mention of ABWEHR collaboration, whereas at ABW so-called SD partnership in this mission was well-known, addording to Lt. (ex-Major) MULLER!)

#### 311. Croatian Mohamedans for M.E.

(Report No.7, para.202, Referat Maherer Osten.)

In October 1943, EILITZ, of Amt VI, Near East Division, told his friend MERZ conversationally, that his Referat would soon send some Mohamedans from CROATIA to M.E., as their agents. MERZ knows no further details about this planned mission.

#### 312. BEST-STEVENS.

According to MEHRING and EILITZ of AMT VI, SCHELLENBERG, now Amtschef VI, was the German who planned and executed the BEST-STEVENS coup. MERZ has heard that these two British officers are now confined to H.Q. AMT VI (STAPO), in Prinz Albrechtstrasse 8, BERLIN.

#### 313. Amtschef III.

MERZ now recalls that SS. Brigadeführer OHLENDORF is C.O. Amt III (SD).

### 314. Location of Morcy Section of STAPO (Amt IV A 4).

Prinz Albrechtatrasse 8, BERLIN, (STAPO Building), Third Floor Back, overlooking gardens back of No.8 and No.9. MERZ worked in this section for a few weeks in February 1942.

#### 315. STAPO Interrogation.

He disclaimed any knowledge of a separate STAPO (Amt IV) Interrogation Section. He had himself only helped with interrogation of a few Poles in SIPO Aussenstelle, KIEICE, in 1940/41. He has heard, however, that foreign agents are normally interrogated at the STAPO Leitstelle nearest to the place of capture. Important agents are sent to STAPO H.Q., Prinz Albrechtstrasse 8 and presumably housed in the basement, like BEST and STEVENS. No-one below the rank of Kriminal-Kommissar is allowed to interrogate them.

- 316. MERZ maintains that high-class agents or suspects are well treated. He cited as an example ROWECKI who, according to SPILKER, was destined for AMT IV. "It would have been folly to mete out severe treatment to one who might be useful to the Germans". (6, para 56). Hence the word "Hausarrest" (open arrest) is applied to the confinement of "guests" at AMT IV.
- 317. From the third floor of Albrechtstrasse 8 (See para.313), MERZ caught occasional glimpses of guests being exercised in the back garden of Albrechtstrasse 9, the grounds of which are out of bounds to all officials

of SIPO except those directly concerned with the "guests", who are all in mufti. MERZ heard only the names of ROWECKI, BEST and STEVENS mentioned. He does not think that he ever saw them.

#### 318. Sections of Referat IV E, RSHA (See 7, para 190.).

MERZ has refreshed his memory on the Counter-Espionage Division of AMT IV (STAPO). There are at least five sections in it. IV E 1 is probably the section for English-speaking countries (Great Britain, U.S.A., Canada, etc.), and is called Abteilung WEST. MERZ knows nothing about Abt. 2, 3, 4. Kriminalrat SCHMITZ is probably in Abteilung 5, also called Abt. SÜDEN (Spain, Portugal, possibly also South America.)

#### 319. AMT VI, Berkaerstrasse, GRUNEWALD. Dr. GRAVE (GRAFE ?).

C.O. Referat Naherer Osten (Near East Division), R.S.H.A., and Kriminal Kommissar EILITZ of the same division, have offices on the first floor (Hochparterre) of H.Q. AMT VI in Berkaerstrasse. MEHRING is in Abteilung WIRTSCHAFT of AMT VI, having been transferred there from the HOLLAND section of Referat A (?), WESTEUROPA (?). MEHRING's office (Wirtschaft) is on the floor above Dr. GRAVE's, i.e. on the second floor.

#### 320. Agents of AMT IV (see 7, end of para.167).

HALMERSEGGER is I C of all AMT IV agents, i.e. of undercover-men, penetration ag its, informers, agents-provocateurs, etc., in the Reich, and in occupied territory under German civil administration. The technical term in SIFO for these agents is VERTRAUENSLEUTE (confidence men).

- 321. All reports from these men eventually reach HALMERSEGGER, those from agents in occupied territory via IV D.
- J22. In Report No.7, para.167, HALMERSEGGER's location was wrongly stated due to a misinterpretation of the ambiguous German phrase "Er sitzt gegenüber dem MÜLLER" (He sits opposite MÜLLER). In fact, his office is on the same floor as MÜLLER's, across the hall.
- 323. MERZ derived his knowledge of HALMERSEGGER from conversations with ECKERLE, .C. Mercy Section, AMT IV.

#### 324. Q.M. Stores - Clothing, SIPO.

Another source had stated that STAPO had an office for surveillance of foreign workers at Burgstr.28, BERLIN, under Kriminalrat MAURER. MERZ was asked why he had not mentioned Burgstrasse 28. He replied that he had considered it of no interest to us, as it was the place where SIPO uniforms are issued (KLEIDERKAMMER der SIPO). He had not heard of a section for the surveillance of foreign workers, nor of Kriminalrat MAURER.

#### 325. SD (AMT III) in Occupied Territory.

In the Generalgouvernment and probably in all ather occupied territories under German civil administration, SD sections of SIPO deal only with investigation of various matters, as described in 7, paral66. SD has No executive functions, contrary to recent reports from other sources. MERZ is 326. Stay Behind Organisations.

MERZ knows of none in POL.ND. In Greece no real preparations have been made by the Germans as far as he knows. In Summer 1943, the Italians were still in charge of such matters and MERZ assumes, from what he has heard, that they have told us about any preparations made by them. German-controlled Stay-Behind Groups would, in MERZ's opinion, be organised by AMT IV (STAPO), not by any other Amt.

327. Capture of Anglo-Italo-Hellenic Military Mission to Communist Andartes.

HÖSSELB ARTH told MERZ that in case of an impending British invasion

of Greece the Germans would not bother about the Greek Communists as they felt that the British would have the same difficulties with them as the Germans. As illustration he related the following to MERZ:

J28. In September (?) 1943, when the British occupied some of the Dodecanese Islands, they heard that on one which they had not yet reached (MERZ does not remember the name of this island) the Communist Andartes had disarmed the Italian garrison. The British sent a W/T message (intercepted by the Germans!) to the Communists asking them to re-arm the Italians who would make common cause with them. The Andartes replied that they considered all Italians enemies of the Greeks and refused restitution of arms to them. Thereupon a military commission, consisting of a British Lt.-General, an Italian Colonel and a Greek Captain, was sent to the island. The Andartes refused to negotiate with this commission which therefore tried to return to its base. The three officers were captured by an Italian officer in an Italian S-boat (Schnellboot) were presumably taken to some port in Greece and were handed over to the Germans.

(Note by I.O.: This story has a foundation of truth and is inserted here merely to illustrate in what garbled form MERZ has presented it. On the other hand it also shows that the German W/T interception is quite efficient and that the original version of the story was probably uncomfortably accurate.)

#### R. UNCLASSIFIED INFORMATION.

#### (a) GERMANY.

329. First Open Criticism of N.ZIS. (See SIME Report No.5, p.3, 30 or 31 July, 1943.)

After a severe air-raid MERZ tried to reach his family in HAMBURG but was unable to go further than LÜNEBURG because train services were interrupted. All stations in the neighbourhood of HAMBURG were crowded with refugees from the stricken city and for the first time MERZ heard them curse the Nazi Government openly without any interference on the part of Nazi officials.

#### 330. Russian Penetration of German Air Ministry.

MERZ does not know of any penetration of SIPO by RUSSIA or any other country. There was, however, a sensational discovery of Russian intrigue in the Luftfahrtsministerium, late in 1942 or early in 1943. In SIPO circles the following version of the story was current:

The Russians had dropped many parachutists somewhere in Germany. On one, who was captured, was found an "Abrechnung" (statement of expenditures) for a Staatssekretar (Secretary of State) of the Air Ministry. This led to the discovery that a number of officials in this ministry, including some senior officers, were in the pay of MOSCOW. Many arrests were made.

#### 332. ' Issue of German Passports.

They are issued by the Chief of Police (Polizeiprasident) of the provincial capital nearest to applicant's domicile. MERZ pointed out that a bad mistake had been made in his case by AMT VI who had his passport made out by the Polizeiprasident of BERLIN but gave his domicile as HAMBURG. MERZ thought that we had noticed this error.

333. MERZ believes that a series of numbers are generally reserved for AMT VI passports. His number if 07556S43, and is dated 28th June 1943. Passports with similar numbers issued about the same time are probably reserved for AMT VI.

FORSTSCHUTZ (Forest Guards). 334. (See also Report No.7, para.14.7)

### (r) POLLND.

#### of negotiation 337. British and Polish Officers near CR.COW.

ANDRZEJ, late chief of M.i.P., told MERZ that he had seen a Scottish officer (captain ?) who was near CRACOW. This officer and three Polish officers had arrived separately in Poland, in the spring of 1943, presumably from England. These officers were to contact Z.w.Z. and were to prepare the Poles for the arrival of parachutists and/or air-borne troops. The Scots officer and the Poles did not meet members of Z.w.Z. possibly because they missed the exact spot for the rendez-vous and therefore contacted M.i.P. ANDRZEJ, asothe leader of the secret organisation, met them several times near CRACOW. (MERZ does not remember of he was told the exact place where they are or were) ANDRZEJ was in tought with Germans at the time for grandiose plans for a new Poland (See Report No.5, para.33). MERZ thinks it likely that MDRZEJ informed the Germans of the presence of the Scots officer and his three Polish military collaborators.

MERZ added that STEFAN's sister; WL.DISLAWA (WALLY) MAJCHRZAK is the only person left now who could contact the Scots and Polish officers.
Wally lives in Stefans house: Goldstrasse 3 (Vlica Zlota 3), KIELCE.

#### Waffen SS and Army (Report No.7, para.258). 343.

MERZ has heard of friction between HIMMLER and senior army officers over the preferential treatment given to Waffen SS, especially in RUSSIA. Waffen SS get better equipment and supplies than their fellow combattants of the Army. The discrepancy is particularly noticeable in FLK and hy arty. Waffen SS are repeatedly withdrawn during or after a heavy battle, are given a long rest behind the German lines and are regrouped and refitted, while the army enjoys no respite from fighting.

#### Polish Underground Activities and Espionage Abroad.

From Dr. DEUMLING, former O.C. of Amt IV D 2, MERZ heard that the Polish H.Q. for espionage and underground activities directed against the Germans is in BUDAPEST. Another important centre is said to be BUCHAREST whither many Poles had fled in 1939/40. Polish intelligence works almost exclusively for "England" because funds for Poles come chiefly from that country.

#### GREECE.

MERZ has made several vague references to WANDA's contacts with Polish circles in ATHENS. Whenever pressed for details he claims only to have heard of that from WANDA. On one occasion a Polish priest or clergyman (name unknown) whom WANDA had met through the BARUTIS, was said to have offered help to WANDA if conditions should become intolerable for her in

. Williams.

### (d) YUGOSLAVIA.

#### 346.

MERZ was questioned on SIPO activities in YUGOSLAVIA. He disclaimed any first-hand knowledge but admitted that he had been told of negotiations between MIHAILOVIC and the Germans by a travelling companion at the beginning of October 1943. This man, Falter WOLF is an Austrian, has a Polish wife, and is the economic adviser of the German C. in C. at BELGRADE. (For further details see Personalities.) WOLF told MERZ that the Yugoslav Quisling, NEDIC, had had an interview with HITLER and that, since NEDIC's return to YUGOSLAVIA, MIHAILOVIC had begun negotiations with him. At the BELGRADE Kommando der WEHRMACHT, WOLF was told that the Germans would likewise try to contact MIHAILOVIC.

349 Note by I.O.: In this Chapter only MERZ's information is presented. Not all statements can be checked here as many of the names are new to us and must be investigated elsewhere. The material in this paragraph is therefore not to be treated as accurate in all details. Notes based on evidence from other sources have been added only where confirmation or elucidation seems desirable.

MERZ is not likely to have given false names or descriptions because he has built up card indexes himself and knows that a check is possible. He admits that he gave a few false names while posing as a Dutchman. He hoped to be released as a friendly neutral, before his lies had been discovered.

PERSONALITIES .... GERMAN AGENTS, mostly of AMP VI.

Pronounced Saxon dialect in German. History and Mctivities: From Dresden, where he was probably either in STAPO or in SD for a short time. In summer 1942, possibly much earlier, he was appointed Polizeiattache in ATHENS GroNow apparently also chief of SIPO (Amt VI) espionage centre in ATHENS. Generally receives agents at his house between 2000 and 2100 hrs. (6, paras.58, 62-64.) MERZ contacted him several times, reported to him progress made in penetration of .Greek societies, for transmission to AMT (VI?),

BERLIN. Stefan MAJCHRZiK also reported to him on arrival in ATHENS, on orders of AMT VI.

· If SIPO is now firmly installed in GREECE, HOSSELBARTH may either have received a new appointment there cr he

may have been transferred elsowhere (7, para.213).

He complained to MERZ that the Greeks seemed no longer very anxious to co-operate with him since they had ceased to believe in a German victory.

H. told MERZ that RALLIS is and of his good friends in THENS. H. knows intimately HAENEL (No.22) and GRAVE or GRAFE (No.32). D.C. Near East Division, Amt VI.

Note: Another source gives us the name of HESSELB RTH, which would be his own Saxon pronunciation for HÖSSELB RTH. (See "pronounced Saxon dialect", above.)

#### No.2 BAACH or BACH,

SS Hauptsturmführer, reported by another source as ATHENS head of "Amt IV of the S.D." (Gegnerbe-Kämpfungsemt).

MERZ disclaims any knowledge of this man but states that in July/October 1943 he could not have been holding the position as given above for the following reasons: SIPO was not yet installed in ATHENS. Amt IV is not a bureau of S.D. but a bureau of RSHA. S.D. is synonymous with AMT III. If S.D. were represented in ATHENS it would merely have a section as part of the KOMMANDO der SIPO and would administratively be under AMT IV, Referat D.

If BAACH had been in Athens, MERZ would probably have heard of him or met him, as Amt IV were making enquiries about him because of his absence from Germany.

Note by I.O. BAACH's ATHENS address as given by abother source is similar to HÖSSELBARTH'S. BAACH's is said to be No.8 (?) Loukianos Street. MERZ gave HOSSELBARTH's as No.14 "Loukou Arno". MERZ is not always accurate in the pronunciation or spelling of names.

The description of BAACH is not the same as that of HÖSSELBARTH, but there are two similarities: WBoth are stout and approximately of the same height.

confine himself to espionage or counter-espionage on
a high level, but only inside Greece. MERZ met him
several times at the Hotel ATHEN where both were
staying. When MERZ went to Turkey, he left his W/T
receiving set with STEINBERG. MAJCHRZAK had brought
it from AMT VI.

On one occasion STEINBERG told him that he had been asked to meet General ZERVAS, a Greek Nationalist leader, at the house of ex-Prime Minister LOGOTHETO-POULOS, a Greek Quisling. ZERVAS wanted German help against the guerrillas of E.L.A.S. STEINBERG was to carry on preliminary negotiations with ZERVAS. Col. SARAPHIS and possibly Michael THEMILIS were also to be present at the first meeting. MERZ believes that negotiations were broken off, as S. was evasive on subsequent days and seemed to imply that no agreement had been reached (6, para 64 (f)).

Note by I.O.: MERZ volunteered names of German agents and facts about them voluntarily. At least two of them have been checked and found more or less correct.

STEHNBERG's existence was unknown to I.O. at the time of interrogation. Records prove that he was suspected of being an agent in ISTANBUL, but our information was incomplete as it stopped in March 1942. MERZ's version of negotiations with ZERWAS may be given more credence if it is pointed att

that MERZ was not asked for names of any specific agent in ATHENS but of those of any he knew. He was not told which names we knew or what facts, if any, were in our possession. The interrogation having reached an acute state at the time, I.O. thinks it unlikely that MERZ would have risked a lie, for fear of detection. If his report of the meeting between STEINBERG and ZERVAS is incorrect, it would have to be an invention of STEINBERG. On the other hand Michael THEMILIS, an arch-schemer, confirmed this meeting.

PPENBECK. Brund. Dutchmen. Agent of AMT VI.

Description: Age: 34/36, Height: 189 cm. Build: muscular, Hair: blond, receding. Complexion: ruddy. Eyes: Blue. Languages: Seven, including Dutch, German, English, French, Arabic.

History & Activities: Said to be the son of a Dutch hotel wwner. For several years before the war he had been a merchant in M.E., especially in CAIRO. According to MERZ he is "a typical cosmopolitan polyglot" whose one aim is to avoid trouble and go through the war without any physical or financial discomfort to himself". He has become an agent for amt VI; but does not seem to be engaged in active field work, as he had many connections in M.E. he was to recruit agents for Amt VI. MERZ met him several times in the WINTERGERIEN, an athens cabaret or bar which is but of bounds to German troops. (6, para.64 (b)). According to HOSSELBERTH he had been inefficient in ATHENS, due to innate laziness, and was to be transformed to Amt VI in BERLIN, for a spell of office work, in the hope of getting straightened out. MERZ was under the impression that TAPPENBECK would go over to the other side at the first opportunity.

Tappenbeck told MERZ that the REICHSBAHNVERKEHRSZENTRIE in Athens is the reporting centre (Anlaufestelle) for Lights of Ant VI; (6, para.63.)

Pseudonym or nick-name. Real name unknown. A Greek agent of int VI. employed by HOSSELB.RTH. The Polizei-attache told MERZ in Sept. 1943 that "KOKINOS" would soon be sent to M.E. The Attack. Greek.

MERZ could not remember the name of Amtschef III until this one was read out to him with 200 others! MERZ is certain that MULLER is Amtschef IV and that OHLENDORF is Chief of SD (Amt III) with a higher rank than BARTH gives him. Amt IV is not Wirtschaft but it contains a section called WIRTSCHAFT. MERZ has never seen OHLENDORF. (7, para.166.)

(Unfortunately MERZ does not remember his Christian name or names.) SS Gruppenführer und Amtschef IV.

He was made O.C. section of Munich Nazi Bureau dealing with communists (the new equivalent for this section at RSHA is Amt IV A 1). From Munich he was transferred to Berlin and his promotions followed quickly upon every increase in power of HEYDRICH and HIMMLER. For some time he has been Amtschef IV, although he has not the academic qualifications required for such a post. He remains one of HIMMLER's right-hand men and rumour in SIPO has it that MULLER hopes to replace KALTENBRUNNER ere long.

M. has had several honourable mentions in this series of reports, especially in connection with the negotiations for an agreement between M.i.P., the Polish secret organisation and SIPO. (5, paras.30 & 31.)

SS Gruppenführer, Amtschef V. No details known.

SS Oberführer, Amtschef VI. MERZ has not met him but has heard that he is fairly young, and that he is a Rhinelander. MERZ was told by his friends MEHRING and EILITZ, of Amt VI, that SCHELLENBERG was responsible for the "BEST-STEVENS" plan and its execution. (Nos.171 and 172.)

SS Standartenführer, Amtschef VII (Weltanschauliche Gegnerforschung.)

HIstory & Activities: MAJCHRZAK was born and grew up in POSEN (POZNAN) where he claims to have studied philosophy, at the University, and to have been a member of the Theosophic Society. His mother and sister are said to be still in POSEN. He soon became a communist leader and spent altogether nine years in various prisons for his political activities. In 1932 he was condemned to 12 years of penal servitude. He was set free from KIEICE prison by fellow Poles just before the Germans entered the town. Stefan tried to reach the Russian lines and rejoin his wife and child who had lived in MOSCOW during his incarceration. At LUBLIN he was persuaded by the Polish 1 c (=GSI.2 or 3), a captain of the Air Force, to remain in Poland.

He returned to POSEN where he visited his mother. Thence he went to KIEICE early in 1940 and contacted a former prison mate, Bogdan KOWAISI (No.104), who had made the acquaintance of MERZ. The latter found STEFAN suitable employment through JEROMOWICZ (No.103) a Ukrainian who at that time had the monopoly for KIEICE District for buying all food supplies and selling them to civilians and German officials not on army rations. Stefan was made egg-collector. He employed Jewish agents and managed his end of the food monopoly so well that soon he attracted the attention of German officials at RADOM and was granted an independent egg monopoly for KIELCE area (Eierkennzeichenstelle KIELCE). MERZ claims to be ignorant of any arrangements made at that time for MAJCHRZAK's political activities. MERZ admits, however, that Sin an still has this lucrative monopoly although he moved on to higher things at WARSAW soon after this first great success with the Germans. While at KIELCE, MERZ saw MAJCHRZAK very frequently and "was instructed in the ideology, methods and personalities of communism and the Polish communist party".

As far as MERZ knows or will admit, MAJCHRZAK's first job as a SIPO agent was his mission to WARSAW, in Oct 41. MERZ sent him there to enquire of Mrs. ALBRECHT and others what had become of the Colonel (No.105) and why he had failed to keep his appointment with MERZ and other SIPO officials. (4, page 6, Oct.41 and 5, paras.16-17.)

When Stefan moved to WARSAW he became a permanent SIPO informer and agent-provocateur and contributed largely to the penetration of Polish secret organisations. He collaborated with SPILKER, C.O. SIPO Sonderkommando, WARSAW (No.55). For all this work Stefan received no direct pay but a second concession, the yeast monopoly for WARSAW Province. He now owns a yeast factory, the products of which are sold at exorbitant prices on the black market, without interference from the Germans. The distributing centre is in Institute Street, WARSAW. This and the egg monopoly in KIEICE province have made of the excommunist a wealthy man. Part of his profits go into the party funds of M.i.P., the largest "secret" society in Poland according to MERZ. He did not, however, gain immediate membership of the party. He soon learned to know the leaders of various secret parties, especially of M.i.P. and reported their activities to Sonderkommando SIPO. He also planted various German schames on the Polish politicians.

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Late in 1941 THOMAS, O.C. SIPO KIEICE, forbade MERZ to have any further contacts with STEFAN. As MERZ was dismissed by THOMAS and transferred to BERLIN he disregarded this order.

In April 42 Stefan introduced MERZ to Dr. GRAD. (5, para.26). On his many subsequent visits to WARSAW, MERZ always stayed at Stofans apartment and was supplied liberally with food and drink to take back to Germany.

Stefan, "as a loyal Pole", acted as WANDA's escort as far as VIENNA, where MERZ took over. Early in Sep 43 Stefan again saw MERZ and WANDA in ATHENS, bringing with him some W/T sets for the Greeks, ostensibly from M.i.P. WARSAW, in reality from Amt VI, SIPO, BERLIN.

He returned to WARSAW and either then or before his trip to ATHENS helped SPILKER to procure evidence against six Polish leaders of M.i.P. MERZ is still very vague about Stefan's share in the liquidation of these Poles. However, when MERZ saw him in WARSAW, on 9/10 Oct 43, MAJCHRZAK told him that he had become a member of M.i.P., having convinced its leaders that he had renounced communis After the removal of the old M.i.P. leaders, Stefan wavered between two plans: He was going to be or had already become a member of the new triumvirate of M.i.P. and intended to make of it once more the most powerful Polish secret organisation, convinced its leaders that he had renounced communism. despite SPILKER's opposition. The other plan was a dash for safety to South America with as much as he could take with him of his profits which he had translated into jewelry and precious stones. According to MERZ, he was persuaded by SPILKER to obtain from the DELEGATURA the official Polish sanction for the murder of these six politicians, including ANDRZEJ, the chief, and DR. GRAD who had been in ATHENS with MERZ on an Amt VI mission but a few weeks previously.

OLLEK is supposed to have succeeded as chief of M.i.P. the very man whose murder he instigated.

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Pseudonym, real name unknown to MERZ. Now probably one of the triumvirate of M.i.P., with OLLEK and STEFAN (MAJCHRZAK).

Accurate description unobtainable, as MERZ saw him and OLLEK only a few times, at night.

Approximate description: Age: Approx. 35/37. Height: 176/78 cm. Build: Slender. Face: Oval.

History & Activities: Said to have grown up in U.S.A. and to have taken a degree in engineering at an American University. Became a leading member of M.i.P. and recently chief of M.i.P. in the Wojewodztwo (county) of KIELCE. Just before or just after the "coup de SIPO" he went to WARSAW and took over the leadership of M.i.P. with OLLEK and MAJCHRZAK. MERZ does not know if he was directly connected with the murder of his chiefs.

spelling: SEDEK), styled double agent, by MERZ. Noq employed by Amt VI. (Main facts in signal to LONDON, 21 Dec.43.)

History & Activities: Born (?) in KIELCE. His parents still live there, in Ulica ZLOTA. Before the war, SENDEK was a student at WARSAW University. In spring 43 he was recruited as an Amt VI agent for work abroad, by SPILKER and an Obersturnführer of Amt VI. Member of ONR in which his two brothers are also said to have important posts. In Oct 43 MERZ heard in WARSAW that SENDEK was to go via STOCKHOLM to LONDON, ostensibly as a member of ONR or DELEGATURA, in reality as an agent of Amt VI,

Herbert. Born in LODZ, Poland. Pole, of German extraction. (Main facts in signal to LONDON, 21 Dec.43.) Description: Age: Approx. 26. Height: 168/170.cm. Build: Slender. Hair: blond. Eyes: blue? Complexion: Fair. Good teeth. Talks fast, possibly with slight stammer. Pronounced Polish accent in German. Languages: Perfect Polish and Polish-German.

History & Activites: He was born a Russian subject, at the age of one became a Pole, and served in Polish Army, being promoted cadet-officer (Fähnrich) in cavalry. Upon annexation of LODZ (=LITZMANNSTADT!) Gebauer, who had been classified as Volksdeutscher, became a German citizen. Appointed to RADOM SIPO as interpreter. Also employed as informer by SPILKER at whose office he reported frequently and where. MERZ talked to him two or three times. GEBAUER seemed to use to good advantage the connections he had established whilst in the Polish Army, especially with members of Z.w.Z. and O.N.R.

SIPO agent, now probably in LODZ.

Description: Age: Approx 40. Height: 169/170 cm. Build: fairly stocky, appearance muscle-bound. Complexion: dark. Eyes: dark. Hair: dark blonde, or light brown.

History & Activities: BIGIOSINSKI started his SIPO career as "penetration" agent in Z.w.Z., for Kriminal-rat FUCHS, (No. 60) O.C. Section for Polish Secret Organistions, SIPO Kommando, RADOM.

At the beginning of 1943 ANDRZEJ, fate chief of M.i.P., told MERZ in WARSAW that BIGIOSINSKI was a member of M.i.P. and that he (ANDRZEJ) had discovered that B. was employed by RADOM SIPO. MERZ was requested to drop a hint to FUCHS to have B. transferred elsewhere, for if he remained in M.i.P., ANDRZEJ would have B. "put out of the way." (A. wollte ihn "umlegen" lassen.). Thereupon FUCHS transferred B. to LODZ. MERZ believes that he continues to be a SIPO agent.

LISOWSKI (or similar name). Pole, resident in KIEICE, in Schlossstrasse, or Ulica Zamkowa in one of the few private houses in that street.) Agent of SIPO Aussenstelle, KIELCE.

Description: Age: 28/30. Height: 170 cm.
Build: emaciated. Long face. Turned-up nose. Hair: blond. Eyes: Blue?

History & Activities: Born and brought up in KEELCE. Definitely from 1940 to 42; possibly still, a SIPO "penetration" agent in S.N. (Stronnictwo Narodowo, National Party) in KIELCE. Sometime after MERZ's final departure from KIELCE (Jan 42), he heard that S.N. had discovered LISOWSKI's connection with SIPO and had made an unsuccessful attempt on his life. Despiate this he has remained in KIELCE.

History & Activities: 1939 - early (?) 41, worked in LEMBERG (LWOW- Branch of Z.w.Z. Early 41 transferred to H.Q. Z.w.Z. in WARSAW, as O.C. Section V (Courier System inside Poland), under Gemeral TOKARZEWSKI, first chief of Z.w.Z. (Np.108)1 Late 41 her only child, a 12 year old daughter died (in Russia?).

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Z.w.Z. sent WANDA to H.Q. M.i.P. WARSAW, as "Kontakt", ie. informer or penetration agent. (See also No.99) She was won over to M.i.P. cause and became O.C. Courier Section of this organisation.

In July 43 Dr. GRAD of M.i.P. (No.97) decided to send her to General ANDERS as courier. She was chosen for this mission because of her connections at Polish H.Q., M.E. and because of her unquestioned patriotism and loyalty to M.i.P. She received a German passport in the name of Margarethe HORBACH, Volksdeutsche (Racial German) of CRACOW, although she does not speak German. On 16/17 Aug 43 she went by train to VIENNA, accompanied by Stefan MAJCHRZAK, and on 18 Aug 43 travelled by air to ATHENS with MERZ, whom she knew as a Dutchman, Jan van der LINDE or JANEK, a man working for the liberation of

DIAND:

In ATHENS she spent the first few nights with

later changing over to other addresses, the last
known residence being at the house of a Russian
emigre woman (name unknown) at NIGITARA 12 B, near

OMONIA Square. ATHENS: (In MERZ's possession was emigre woman (name district), at the front en-

OMONIA Square, ATHENS. (In MERZ's possession was found a key which he claims to fit the front entrance door of that house.)

In WARSAW, WANDA had been given verbal instructions which she was to transmit to General ANDERS in person, and also numerous letters and documents for Polish H.Q., M.E. Chief among these documents was the code, with instructions, which was to be used in secret W/T communications between Polish H.Q., M.E. and H.Q., M.i.P. WARSAW. After delivery of these documents and verbal instructions to Polish H.Q., M.E. WANDA was to return to ATHENS with General ANDERS' verbal and/or written reply and Dr. GRAD was to verbal and/or written reply and Dr. GRAD was to contact her there.

Due to endless delays and finally the inability of Greeks to send her to M.E., WANDA handed letters

ANKARA to her cousin and her husband, Mr. and Mrs.

KROTKIEWSKI. MERZ was to return to ATHENS after
10/12 days. The fate of WANDA remains uncertain.

MERZ still denies that she was to be liquidated by and a copy of W/T code to MERZ for delivery in the Germans or others. She was almost penniless
the time of his departure from ATHENS, on 5 Oct
41, and she had very little clothing. She had made
friends with Mrs. BARUTI, a White Russian emigre,
and a Polish priest, whom she had met in ATHENS, was to also to look after her.

(Note by I.O.: In the original of the letter of 13 Aug 43, addressed by him (?) to General ANDERS, he signs himself Szer (-) ANDRZEJ of the Secret, or the Mysterious. The original of the letter was handed to WANDA by ANDRZEJ. When MERZ left ATHENS for TURKEY, WANDA gave him this letter. The original has finally reached us and MERZ has admitted that it could have been written by MAJCHRZAK, whose handwriting is similar to that in the letter. (See 8, para.270.)

History & Activities. Before the war ANDRZEJ was an engineer in WARSAW. He was also one of the chief organisers of Polish sports.

ANDRZEJ and GRAD negotiated for a truce between

M.1.P. and SIPO, through Amt IV (STAPO). An
agreement was made but was broken by HIMMLER in the
spring of 43, (5, para.32). ANDRZEJ decided to
approach HITLER directly (5, para.33).

MERZ now admits that NDRZEJ collaborated with Amt VI; after the fiasco of the M.i.P. - Amt IV agreement. ANDRZEJ was fully aware of Amt VI schemes for abtaining intelligence from M.E. through the Poles and agreed to the transmission to Amt VI of any news brought back from M.E. by a Polish courier, either WANDA or a Polish officer.

ANDRZEJ was murdered in WARSAW streets, in mid-Sep 43, by his own countrymen, at the instigation of SIPO Kommandeur SPIIKER, who had the execution of six Mi.P. leaders sanctioned by the DELEGATURA through OLLEK (No.86), present chief of M.i.P.

(Alias Dr) WIKOLAI, a pseudonym used frequently in Poland and also in ATHENS; alias (Dr) Otto NAMPEL), one of leaders of M.i.P., friend and collaborator of MERZ.

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-SIPO agreement (6, paras.50-51), helped ANDRZEJ to draft memorandum to HITLER (5, para.33), intended to contact ANDERS personally in M.E. in early spring 43 (4, p.8, Winter 42/43), established contact in ATHENS with "friendly" Greeks for MERZ (6, paras. 66-76), selected a courier (WANDA) and sent her to ATHENS with instructions to contact General ANDERS in M.E. and was finally liquidated for his pains, along with ANDRZEJ and four other M.i.P. leaders. · MERZ at long last admits GRAD's collaboration with Amt VI of SIPO, "but only for patriotic reasons", . i.e. better conditions obtained for Poles and the creation of a new German-backed Poland, enlarged in the east at the expense of Russia. GRAD introduced MERZ to members of M.i.P. as a Dutchman. GRAD met other SIPO officials, especially Dr. DEUMLING, former U.C. Amt IV D 2, who has been sent to a SIPO Einsatzkommando in YUGOSLAVIA. GRAD assumed a German name, Dr. Otto HAMPEL, on several occasions, always with the connivance of Amt VI. Hegtried to establish secret W/T connections between Polish H.Q. M.E. and M.i.P. WARSAW.

According to MERZ, Dr. GRAD had a secret "laboratory" in WARSAW. In it he kept most of his anti-German propaganca material and all documents which were to be kept sepret from the Germans. He manufactured false passports and identity cards. G. had made out for himself a "Volksdeutsche Kennkarte" (identity card for "Racial" Germans in Poland) in the name of Dr. Otto HAMPEL, the pseudonym which he later adopted for his genuine German passport, granted by Amt VI for his journey to ATHENS with MERZ. MERZ fears that some false documents which G. had made for him and kept in this office, have falled into the hands of SIPO, during the search made of the laboratory after GRAD's death.

History & Activities: Said to have been a Polish Army officer, rank not known. MERZ claims that in June 43 he was threatened with a revolver by WITOLD. (5, para.22). WITOLD hoped to join the DELEGATURA.

> THOMAS, as soon as he assumed his new post of O.C., KIELCE SIPO, forbade MERZ all further contact or association with KOWAISKI, MAJCHRZAK and others. Nevertheless, MERZ saw both frequently, even after K, had appeared as a witness against him in his trial on charges of exceeding his authority and being too friendly with Poles. K. explained to MERZ that THOMAS had compelled him to testify against him under threat of KZ (Konzentrationslager).

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# (j) POLES WHOSE POLITICAL CONVICTIONS AND ACTIVITIES HAVE NOT BEEN DEFINITELY ESTABLISHED BY MERZ'S EVIDENCE.

No.107 GENERAL ANDERS.

G.O.C. in C., Polish Forces in M.E. MERZ knows of him only through contacts in Poland. According to GRAD, ANDER's family are still in WARSAW. They are all protestants as GRAD discovered during his brief period as protestant clergyman in WARSAW. DR. GRAD (No.97) seemed to consider ANDERS anti-Russian and likely to accede to a request for assistance against Poland's enemy No.1, RUSSIA. GRAD had planned to see ANDERS personally in spring 43. Later GRAD sent a courier, WANDA, with a letter from ANDRZEJ, Chief of M.i.P. (Original now in our hands . It may not emanate from ANDRZEJ but from MAJCHRZAK.) WANDA was to transmit messages verbally to ANDERS, and also a code for the planned M.i.P. (WARSAW) -Polish H.Q. (M.E.) W/T connection. When WANDA could not get to M.E. from ATHENS, MERZ went to TURKEY to contact her relations there and deliver written messages, one of them "ANDRZEJ's" letter to General ANDERS. In ANKARA, Capt. LEDOCHOWSKI, asked MERZ to proceed to ALEPPO, to meet Gen. ANDERS who would specially go there to get firsthand news about Poland and the political situation from him. MERZ, at that time, was thought to be a Dutchman working for Polish freedom. (Note: Due to the intervention of a British officer at ALEPPO, MERZ was not allowed to meet General ANDERS.)

No.108 GEN. TOKARZEWSKI, M

Michael. First chief of Z.w.Z. A popular figure in Poland, as liberator of LWOW (LEMBERG) from the Russians in (1920/21?). He is said to have served under PIISUDSKI. MERZ never met him but heard stories about him from several Poles. Col. ALBRECHT said that General SIKORSKI ordered TOKARZEWSKI to . to go LEMBERG early in 1940, during the Russian occupation, to start a Polish organisation in that area. Later MERZ heard that General T., in the company of Gen. ANDERS, had left Russia for M.E. to organise the new Polish army. In WARSAW there were rumours that T. had returned to Poland. MERZ does not know where he is now. MAJCHRZAK claimed that years ago he and Gen. T. had been members of the same Theosophic Society.

No.109 ROWECKI.

Polish Colonel, reported to have been promoted to General. R. is TOKARZEWSKI's successor as chief of Z.w.Z. R. is a follower of PILSUDSKI, under whom he fought. MERZ knows of him only through others. Col. ALBRECHT (4, p.5, End July 41) was to negotiate a truce between Z.w.Z. and SIPO through Gen. ROWECKI, in Sep.41. (4, page 6, 5 Sep. 15 Sep. Oct 41.) In the summer of 1943 ROWECKI was arrested by SIPO and on orders of HIMMLER was transported to BERLIN in a luxurious A.C., according to SPILKER. (6, para. 56.) He may now be confined to AMT IV (STAPO), Prinz Albrechtstrasse 8, BERLIN, where interrogations of important people are conducted. (9, paras. 314-317.)

No.110 COL. JOZET CZYKOW.

(He may only be a major.) In Polish Forces M.E. Husband of WANDA (Maria JOZEFCZYKOWNA) No.95. Nothing has come to light in the course of the lengthy interrogation of MERZ to implicate him in any plot or act of disloyalty to the Poles or the

ATTies. He happens to be WANDA's husband and a long letter from her to him was taken to ANKARA by MERZ. WANDA, had expressed to MERZ the hope that her husband would somehow get her to M.E.as soon as he heard of her plight in GREECE.

No.111 COLONEL FILIPOWICZ: In 1940 he was chief of Southern Polish Sector of Z.w.Z. Probably still leading personality in Z.w.Z. Was a follower of PILSUDSKI and fought und Report No.5, p.12, para.15.) Colonel F. is

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not known to MERZ.

No.112 Major WIODARKIEWICZ. In 1940 he was Chief of TAP (Tajna Armja Polska),
the Polish Secret Army. He and his group soon joined Z.W.Z., the Polish Secret military league. Early in 1940 he sent Lt. PODZIOMSKI to KIELCE to contact Z.w.Z. groups in that area. (4, p.5, Feb.40, and Report No.5, p.12, para.15.) Maj. W. is not known personally to MERZ.

Lt. PODZIOMSKI, Janucz. Member of Z.w.Z. No.113

Description: Age: 33/34. Slender. Reddish hair. Moustache. Blue eyes.

History & Activities: Was a lieutenant in Polish Gavlary until autumn 39. Was one of foremost Polish horsemen and took part in many competitions.

In Feb 40 PODZIOMSKI came to KIELCE, from WARSAW, to contact or organise Z.w.Z. groups in the area.
At first SIPO restricted his movements but apparently did not arrest him. He agreed to contact Col. FILIPOWICZ, chief of Z.w.Z. for Southern Poland and to help to negotiate a truce between Z.w.Z. and SIPO. MERZ escorted him to CRACOW for that purpose. return empty-handed to KIELCE. SIPO KIELCE thereupon decided to send him to SIPO Kommandeur RADOM. Lt. P. and MERZ realised that this was tantamount to a death sentence for the lieutenant. When MERZ escorted P. to RADOM a few days later, he allowed him to escape. MERZ rejects most vehemently the imputation of possible liquidation of the lieutenant and states that P's wife and parents-in-law, who live in KIEICE, can testify to the accuracy of the story as related to I.O.

Lt. PODZIOMSKI's parents live in SUCHEDMOW (?), on the KIEICE-RADOM road.

Stefan MAJCHRZAK's assistant in the egg-monopoly at RIEICE. Poland

K. had been a student at the School for Politics (Ecole des Sciences Politiques, or Politische Hochschule) at MOSCOW and was then chief of the Baltic Section of KOMINTERN. Later he collaborated with Stefan in the Polish Communist party and both probably spent some time together in WARSAW prison . The latter's transfer to a similar institution in KIELCE.

In 1940 MAJCHRZAK employed his old comrade in his German-granted egg business at KIELCE. There MERZ vas introduced to him by Stefan. KWIATKOWSKI disclaims any further interest in politics but MERZ learned a great deal about Russian Communism from The him, as welling from Stefan.

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No.115 JANICKI. Collaborator of MAJCHRZAK in the reast Monopoly in WAIRAY.

Not a SIPO agent, according to MERZ.

Description: Age: approx.42/45. Height: 173 cm. Build: Slender: Hair: Black. Black moustache. Eyes: dark: Heavy eyebrows.

History & Activities: Owner of a WARSAW Hotel, probably the Europezski in Marshall Street. Also "representative" of MAJCHRZAK in the yeast monopoly. As he earns large sums of money he contributes occasionally to the party funds of M.i.P. Said to be unscrupulous in his business deals.

No.116 MAJCHRZAK, WLADISLAWA (WALLY), Sister of Stefan (No.85). Lives in her brother's house in KIELCE, Uliber ZLOTA No.3

her brother's house in KTELCE, Ulica ZLOTA No.3 (Goldstresse 3).

Description: Age: 40 approx. Height: 165.

Build: Average, but sports a very powerful, protruding chest. Head: large, egg-shaped, similar to her brother's. Hair: blond.

History & Activities. Although MERZ states that she does not work actively for SIPO, she is fully aware of her brother's activities for SIPO, in and through Polish Secret Organisations.

No.117 BALISINSKA, Renate. Polish girl-friend of MERZ.

Description: Age: 22. Height: 160 cm. Build: slender. Hair: black, Eyes: brown.

History & Activities: Father owns a pharmacy in KIELCE, in Ulica SIENKIEWICZA. According to MERZ the girl does not belong to any political party.

She associated with MERZ merely because she considered him a presentable fellow-me-lad. In 1942 and 1943 she appeared as witness against MERZ, upon the insistence of THOMAS, former O.C. SIPO Aussenstelle, KIEICE. (See KOWALSKI, No.104). Her room or flat was searched on orders of THOMAS early in 1942, after MERZ's transfer to BERLIN. Only a few books of MERZ were found. Apparently THOMAS had hoped to find evidence against MERZ.

HERMANOWA, No.118

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Maria. Of Al. JEROZOLIMSKIE 85, Apt. No.9, WARSAW. Possibly a relation of WANDA (No.95) or her husband (No.110) and also possibly of Mrs. KRYSTYNA KROTIEWSKA (No.154) of ANKARA. On 20/21 Aug 43 WANDA probably wrote a post-card from ATHENS to HERMANOWA, who wrote a post-card from WARSAW (post office date stamp 12 Oct 42) to Krystyna KROTKLEWSKA (ANKARA) saying that she (Hermanowa) had not heard for some weeks from SLAWKA (also called SLAWECZEK, Christian name of WANDA's husband). See 8, paras. 300-301.

No.119 DUTKOW, Jasi.

Name found in WANDA's letter to her husband. WANDA wrote: "Do your best to get Mr. Janek (Note: MERZ) to return to me soon. When you write to occupied territory write to the following address:

Dutkow Jasi,

Here is the exact address and the name:

Janina Samplowksa, WARSAWA, Aleje Jerozolimski 21 m 21.

(Note: m = apartment)

Note by I.O.: In the same letter are found some strange figures. In this case 21 m 21, in WANDA's end of No.95. own WARSAW address the tel. No. 3.71.17. See also rant – Di s Zoton o omboligave im

No.120 MISS KOT. Sister of Prof. KOT, who is now in LONDON. Miss KOT is said to be the leader of the women's section of M.1.P.

Among other letters handed to MERZ by MAJCHRZAK, in VIENNA, for transmission to M.E., was one supposedly written by Miss Kot to her brother, Minister KOT.
in this letter there is not a single personal touch
of the supposed writer, not a word about personal
or family matters. It is a brief semmon against Z.w.Z., now called A.O.K., and a plea for support for M.i.P., not only from Prof. KOT but also from "Minister" Dr. Vr. KUKIEL.

MERZ claims not to know Miss KOT nor any details about this message.

Note by I.O.: As ANDRZEJ, a letter to General ANDERS may have been written by Stefan MAJCHRZAK, as MERZ has finally admitted, this letter to Prof. KOT may also have been written by someone not directly connected with Miss Kot.

No.121 DR.

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ZAMOJSKI, and his wife. Not connected with any political plot nor with espionage or counter-esplonage of any country, according to MERZ, who met them socially only at KIEICE in 1940/41. They are relations of BOGDAN KOWALSKI. (See No.104.)

No.122 Mmm. IDZIOKOWSKA. Or similar name. Member of ONR in a German Concen. tration camp. She and some other members of the party were released by the Germans in 1942, after the truce agreement between O.N.R. and SIPO. (5, p.13, para.21.)

UNCLASSIFIED GERMANS IN ATHENS.

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(Sonderfuhrer.) Editor of German Naval publication for Aegean. "Der Lowe wor Hellas." AX Hens Free Description: Age: 35/38. Height: 178 cm. Build:

Stout. Complexion: dark. Hair: dark brown.

Probably Woods. Face: round. Probably wears glasses.

History & Activities. MERZ met him on an A.C. on the journey from VIENNA to SOFIA on 16 Oct 43. MERZ gathered from the conventation he had with him that he does part time work for some German intelligence organisation but does not know if this is Amt V1. FRIEDRICHS told him that he had a flat in ATHENS but for security reasons could not give the address.

Before the war he had a small publishing firm for. scientific works.

On arrival at SOFIA, on the evening of 16 Oct 43, MERZ had dinner with FRIEDRICHS and Col. HOLBERG. (5, p.7, 16 Oct. 43, and Report No.6, para.64 (c).)
FRIEDRICHS invited MERZ to visit him in ATHENS, No.124 Col. HOLBERG. A German FLAK offr.

Description: Age 50 approx. Height: 180 cm.
Build: muscular. Complexion: ruddy. Round face. History and Activities: May be in FLAK in Southern Greece. Has a flat in Hotel CARLTON, PHALERON. (5, p.7, 15 Oct 43). MERZ met him on an A.C. from

Vienna to SOFIA, on 16 oct.43. HOLBERG said that he had just completed a course in antiaircraft tactics (Abwehrtaktik), in BERLIN. MERZ told HOLBERG that he expected to be in ATHENS in a few days (after his trip to Turkey!) and received an invitation from the Colonel to visit him.

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Christian wame unknown. Lt. (Oberleutnant) of Luftwaffe, I.C. technical equipment of the Signals (W/T) Section, (Technische Nachrichten Abteilung) of the Luftgaukommando ATHEN, PANSPISTIMIOUS Street. He is a brother of Walter WOLF (No.160) who gave MERZ the above address when he heard that he was going to ATHENS. MERZ states that he never visited Lt. WOLF in ATHENS.

SEKRETAR, No.126

Name unknown. In HOSSELBARTH's house, Loukou Armo 14, (=Loukianos 14?), ATHENS. Description: Age: 45/50. Height: 178 cm. approx. Build: heavy, robust. Hair: blond, almost bald. Complexion: ruddy. The "Sekretar" is a Saxon.

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In HOSSELBARTH's office. Name forgotten. A young Greek, obviously cultured and well-spoken. Description: Age: 25/26. Height: 178 cm. (?) Build: very slender. Face: thin, pointed chin. Complexion: fair. Hair: Blond. General appearance: Central European. Languages: .Fluent Greek and German, possibly other languages.

SHORTHAND-TYPIST. In HOSSELBARTH's office. Name unknown. German girl from LEIPZIG. Girl-friend of Finnish Consul in ATHENS, according to HOSSELBARTH.

> Description: Age: 28 (?) Height: 170 cm. Build: Plump. Complexion: pale. Hair: blond.

No.129 HOUSEKEEPER. In HOSSELBARTH's house. Name unknown. Middleaged Greek woman who generally answers the doorbell.

Of HOSSELBARTH. Name unknown. A Greek, aged approximately 40.

No.131 GERMAN, Name unknown, apparently Chief of office staff of railway tourist office (Reichsbahnverkehrszentrale), ATHENS, which is used by AMT VI as a reporting centre for its agents.

Description: Age: 38/39. Build: Very fat. Hair: blond, growing bald. Large nose.

No.132 WOMAND EMPLOYEE

Name unknown, Reichsbahnverkehrszentrale, ATHENS. 'Volksdeutsche ("Racial" Garman) from the UKRAINE. Pronounced Russian accent in German.

Note by I. . : Some of the Greek names given below are probably fictitious although MERZ accepted them all at face value.

THEMILIS, = (=THEMELIS?), Michael. Greek, self-styled leader of Dodecanese group in E.A.M.

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Description: Age: 41/42. Height: 166/168 cm. Build: heavy, hunched shoulders, ape-like posture. Head appears to be set immediately on shoulders, without intervening neck. Very heavy body, hands covered with thick black bair. Round head and face. Hair: crinkly, black, greying. Heavy black eyebrows. Eyes almond-shaped. Facial features Mongolian.

History & Activities: Merchant in WARSAW for 15 years, until 1940 when he returned to Greece. Seems to be in touch with and claims to represent Communists, Democrats and Nationalists. He is the most versatile Greek MERZ and his collaborators met in ATHENS. THEMILIS managed to hoodwink not only GRAD, but also MAJCHRZAK, which was no mean achievement. First to promise to Dr. GRAD a safe passage for WANDA to M.E. and last to back out of promise. MERZ seems to have realised only in retrospect the extent of THEMILIS' craftiness. (5, p.2, 9/10 Jul. 43; p.4, 19 Aug 43, 9/10 Sep 43. Report No.6, paras 69-73, 76, 80, 82, 84, 85, 92, 93, 96).

Note by I.O. The ATHENS telephone directory of 1940 lists a Michael THEMILIS, of

MERZ gave his address as:

A Leader of E.A.M. ATHENS address: Avenue

fluent German.

History & Activities: LADRIS claims to have studied at BERLIN University and to be an engineer. In 1923 he went to MOWCOW and was trained in communism. He returned to ATHENS with the mission to give special training to "one hundred of the most intelligent Greek Communists". He claims to have failed in this mission. With MERZ he posed as a fervent communist. To this day MERZ is uncertain about his exact position in EAM but belives him to be one of the most important members of this organisation, perhaps its political leader. MERZ was told that the house where he met LADRIS in ATHENS is H.Q. EAM (Avenue Alexander or Alexandra No. 26.) Aside from this house LADRIS owns considerable property in the STADION area and in PHALERON, also a country house in the foothills of the mountains near ATHENS, a short distance from the country terminus of tram-line No.12. It was there that MERZ and WANDA made LADRIS's acquaintance. (6, paras. 82, 95, 96.)

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YANOULIS told MELL that LADRES was not considered a good communist, due to his wealth, but that he was needed by the Communists because of the large sums of money be contributed to the party funds.

Note by I.O.: ATHENS Telephone Directory of 1940 gives both Philippinos and Soterios LAPDIS at ALEXANDRAS Avenue No. 26 (same address as MERZ has indicated. Tel: 63358.

The following information about Philippinos and Soterio's LARDIS was obtained quite independently of MERZ, from a different source:

Ph. LARDIS is a wealthy Greek. His father had much property which he and his brother inherited. His ATHENS residence is in Alexandras Avenue, corner of Spyridonos Tricoupi. The buildings flanking his residence, on both sides of the corner, are his property. One of these buildings is a school owned by a certain AEDONOPOULOS.

P. LARDIS is said to be a VENIZELIST or Democrat.
Before the war he frequented German circles in
ATHENS, especially German women in cabarets. He was
and is still a "grand coureur". His orgies used to
take place in one of his houses at a place called
"TRIS GEFTRAES". He moves in German circles in
ATHENS and "can easily be accused of co-operation with
with the Axis authorities". He is anti-British.
His brother, Soterios is said to be pro-German.
P. LARDIS has property situated at PAGRATI, near
the terminus of tram line No.12. (MERZ had stated
the same, without the place name, PAGRATI.)

Soterios LARDIS is the Greek agent of BOSCH Electrical Equipment, with an office at Kapodistria Street, in the building which extends as far as and includes Patissia St. No.32.

A sister of LARDIS married a well-known Athenian, a certain GERTSOS, one of several brothers who were representatives of a number of German firms, amongst which was BOSCH Electrical Equipment. The office of GERTSOS Bros. was at Patissia Street No.32 where the German Cypher Section is now situated. The GERTSOS are said to be very pro-German. They are supposed to have fled to SWITZERLAND.

No.135 YANOULIS,

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A director of the Greek Nations. Broadcasting system.

Description: Age: 37 approx. Height: 170 cm. Build: Slender. Hair: black. Eyes: large, brown. Strong facial features. Large mouth.

History & Activities: YANOULIS claims to have studied at American and French Universities, principally politics. He also states that he had been a close friend of General METAXAS. He is now officially employed as a director at the Greek National Broadcasting System, and, like FANTOULIS, at the same time as leader of communist groups. YANOULIS claims to be a personal friend of General ARIS. MERZ and WANDA had several meetings with YANOULIS. (6, paras.82, 86, 96). YANOULIS signed a letter to "Comrades" NICOLAI (Dr. GRADand STEPHAN (Steran Majchrzak), in MERZ's presence. The latter claims not be have noticed that the Gree signed the wrong name. When shown the signature, which looks like IOMAS or THOMAS, MERZ said that this might be the true name of the man, not YNOULIS. (See No.141).

CHIEF OF THE GREEK BROADCASTING SYSTEM. No.136 (Not personally known to MERZ, name forgotten.

> HÖSSELBARTH told MERZ that the director (not identical with FANTOULIS) was an influential member of K.A.M. and that the Germans knew that he had found employment for many of his party people in the Greek Broadcasting System.

Greek broad-caster on Greek National Broadcasting System, ATHENS. Cousin of Michael THEMILIS,

Doscription: Age: 35/36. Height: 172/174 cm. Build: Very slender. Complexion: swarthy. Hair: Black. Small black moustache. Face: thin. Eyes: brown. Good teeth. Jead rot and course. History & Activities: Not certain whether born in

Poland or in Greece, but spent many years in Poland and speaks fluent Polish. His father is said to be still living in CRACOW. Before the war FANTOULIS translated several Polish books into Greek. Since the German occupation of Greece he has become officially a broadcaster, claims to be also the leader of several communist groups in PIRAEUS and the editor of a Greek Communist paper. (MERZ saw a copy of this paper, which bears the emblem of the hammer and sickle.) MERZ, GRAD, STEFAN MAJCHRZAK and WANDA made the acquaintance of FANTOULIS in ATHENS: (6, paras.74, 81-85, 91-93, 95-96.)

No.138 FANTOULIS. Father of George (No.137). George told MERZ his father is still living in CRACOW. No other details

No.139 C OSTAS.

Probably a pseudonym, Christian name only known. Greek communist.

Description: Age: 52/55. Height 166 cm. approx. Build; slender, emaciated. Complexion: swarthy. Hair: black, turned grey. Eyes: dark.

History & Activites: Said to have been an "author" before the war. Now writer of articles for communist papers, and Chief of Intelligence Section of Greek Communist Party in ATHENS.

MERZ and WANDA met him several times at conferences where arrangements were made for WANDA's trasnport to M.E. (6, para.82 and 96.)

No.140 LEONIDAS. Probably a pseudonym, Christian name only known. Greek communist.

Description: Age: looks 48/50, may be younger. Height: 173/175 cm. Build: Very slender. Face: pinched. Thin nose. Pointed chin. Good teeth. Hair: black.

History & Activites: Claims to be good friend of General ARIS and a communist leader. MERZ and WANDA met him several times. (6, paras. 82 and 86.)

No. LLI SKOPA Pseudonym, real name not known. At beg Oct 43, MERZ was given a letter by YANOULIS, addressed to Dr. GRAD and MAJCHRZAK presumably signed by SKOPA and YANOULIS. (6, para.99). YANOULIS told him that SKOPA was the chief of the Greek Communist Party. MERZ never met SKOPA and had never heard of him Q before.

Note by I.O.; The original of the letter has finally been handed over to the British. Neither roears on it as given by MERZ from signature יותחת החיו

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memory. After "salutations fraternelles" there appears, in brackets, the typewritten werd SCOIA. in capital letters. The signature beneath that is definitely not YANOULIS;; it looks like I. LOMAS, or I. LOUMAS, or THOMAS. Underneath that appears the signature "WANDA".

SCOPA (not SKOPA) may be the initials for Sossialistikos Communistikos Organismos Patrioton Apelevtheroseos or something like Patriotic Socialist Communist Organisation for Liberation.

In fine, SKOPA is probably not a person, but a political organisation, and MERZ may have been once more the dupe of Hellenic craftiness.

A/m letter and other letters and documents will form the topic of a subsequent report.

No.142 "GENERAL" ARIS.

Chief of "Communist" Andartes (E.L.A.S.) in mountains. MERZ has never met him. He is said to have assumed the rank of general, but held a lower rank in the Greek Army. WANDA was to go to ARIS and was to be flown from there to M.E. Through Michael THEMILIS, LADRIS and others, MERZ learned many of the secrets of E.L.A.S. and transmitted them to Amt.VI in BERLIN through Polizeiattache HÖSSELBARTH. (6, paras.109-127.)

No.143 GENERAL (?) ZERVAS, Leader of Nationalist Andartes in Greek mountains. MERZ has not met him. In Sep 43 fighting broke out between the Nationalist Andartes and E.L.A.S. guerrillas. ZERVAS sought the help of the Germans against his "communist" rivals in the mountains, according to STEINBERG. MERZ believes that the negotiations between STEINBERG, an AMT VI agent, ZERVAS, and possibly also Col. SERAPHIS and Michael THEMILIS, at the house of Quisling, (exprime minister) LOGOTHETOPOULOS, proved abortive. (See Nos.3, 144, 133, and Report No.6, para.64 (f) Note.)

COLONEL SERAPHIS. Leader of a group of National Andartes, under

Gen. ZERVAS. MERZ has not met him. Michael

THEMILIS stated that he was a friend of Col.

SERAPHIS and his representative in ATHENS.

SERAPHIS was to be present at a conference between

Amt VI agent STEINBERG and leader of Nationalists,

General ZERVAS, at the house of Quisling (ex-prime

minister), LOGOTHETOPOULOS. (6, para.64(f), Note.)

SERAPHIS's mother lives on the first floor of

Michael THEMILIS's ATHENS residence, at Makri No.8,

No.145 LOCCTHETOPOULOS. For a short time Greek Prime Minister. A Quisling is the word used by MERZ, who has not met him. In Sep 43 he arranged a conference at his house between STEINBERG (No.3) Amt VI agent, General ZERVAS (No.143) Col. SERAPHIS (No.144) and possibly Michael THEMILIS (No.133).

Retired Greek officer: Speaks Greek, French and probably Russian. ATHENS address: A villa surrounded by a large garden, in Socrates or Stotelou Street, just behind Voyainou Street, or around the comer from daughter's house (No.148).

DECLASSIFIED Authority NND 39210 Description: Age: 55 approx. Height: 170 cm. Build: stout. Hair: grey. Moustache.

History & Activites: Little known about him aside from previous service in Greek army. Now apparently in contact with Greek Nationalists. A perfect gentleman, according to MERZ. Tried to put MAJCHRZAK in touch with Nationalists in order to arrange for WANDA's journey to M.E. (Report No.6, paras. 68, 79, 90, 102.) Although a Nationalist he put GRAD and MERZ into touch with Michael THEMILIS, a member of EAM.

No.147 Mmm. BARUTI.

White Russian Emigre. Wife of BARUTI, retired Greek officer.

Description: Age: 49/50. Height: 168/170. Build: slender. Complexion: dark. Hair: black. Eyes: brown. Straight back.

Languages: Russian, Greek, French, German.

History & Activities: Said to be daughter of a Russian Prince. MERZ thinks that he and GRAD were told this to impress them with her importance. WANDA confided most, if not all her secrets in Mme. BARUTI who felt very sympathetic towards her in her dilemma. MERZ states that Mme. BARUTI, unlike her husband, had a very good eye for any loose change not definitely ear-marked for immediate needs of WANDA or MERZ.

No.148 DAUGHTER OF BARUTI. Married name forgotten. ATHENS address:

Trikor No.8, just off Septembriou Street, around
the corner from father's residence.

Description: Age: 27/28. Height: 165 cm. Build: slender. Hair: dark-blond. Round face. Small, round, turned-up nose. Languages: Greek, Polish.

History & Activities: At Warsaw ballet school where Dr. GRAD met her. Dancer in ATHENS theatre until her marriage to leader of orchestra. Dr. GRAD's first contact in ATHENS, on 11 or 12 July 43. (6, para.68.)

No.149 SON-in-LAW+of BARUTI. Greek, name forgotten. Orchestra leader in Greek National Theatre, ATHENS. Same . address as his wife, Baruti's daughter.

Description: Age: 38/40. Height: 172 cm. approx. Build: very slender. Complexion: Swarthy. Eyes: brown. Hair: black.

Languages: Greek, German.

History & Activities: Studied music in Germany and in VIENNA. Now leader of orchestra at Greek National Theatre. Gonducted first performance of CARMEN at Theatre, in summer or autumn 43. He is a member of the Nationalist party and probably takes part in its activities.

No.150 "SUSIE",

: 1.5

Real name not known. Greek dance hostess at "Wintergarten", ATHENS.

Told MERZ one day that she and another Greek girl there (No.151) had been approached by a German to watch some suspicious Swedes who were frequenting the Wintergarten. (7, para.262).

MERZ told this girl that he was going to TURKEY. She gave him a letter for her sister in ISTANBUL. (No.155).

No.151 SECOND GREEK DANCE HOSTESS. Name unknown. "Wintergarter" ATHENS.

See No.150, above.

No.152 LUDOCHOWSKI.

OCHOWSKI. (C., ). (OR LUDOCHOWSKI, according to MERZ , who has only heard his name. According to another source it is LUDOCHOWSKI.) .: + 15/41/4 , D. C. (17-7)

Polish Captain, 2nd Bureau, ANKARA, 1000.

Description: Age: Approx.35. Height: 180 cm.

Build: Solid, muscular. Right arm stiff at elbow, as result of wound. Hair: Blond.

History & Activities: Told MERZ that he had been a courier for Z.w.Z. for brief period in 1939/40. Subsequently enlisted in Polish Army in M.E. Was with British 8th Army in Western Desert. Took part in several battles. Wounded at BARDIA. Says that he is now employed in Polish Intelligence in TURKEY. Met MERZ on his first day in ANKARA, at KROTKIEWSKI's apartment, on 18 Oct 43, and again on 19 and 20 Oct 43. 

### Colonel Roehmert

1. The contract of Lt.-Colonel Herbert Bochmert, armament and equipment expert of the German advisory group in Egypt, expired at the end of 1953 and was not renewed. Boehmert had been given notice during the first bull of 1953 (see Paragraphs 23 and 24 of JX-4380) that his contract would not be renewed. His successor is Otto Ellendt.

### Colonel Zolling

Intelligence adviser, was dismissed in early 1954. Dr. Wilhelm Voss had then instructed as early as October 1953 to look for a suitable successor to Zolling (the information as reported in Paragraph 11 of JI-4415 and insugraph 13 of JX-4354 referred most probably to this rather than to Voss' search for someone to organize an overall Egyptian security authority). Relations between Zolling and Voss had remained as bad as previously reported (see Paragraph 11 of JX-4380 and Paragraph 11 of JX-4354), and Zolling was reported to have sent damaging reports against Vosc and the Voss faction to the Gehlen organization in Germany.

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### Dr. Dueumling

- 3. Zolling's successor is Dr. Joachim Daeumling, born at Bugerhof (Oldenburg) on 25 January 1910 and holder of passport #1325/52 issued at Dusseldorf on 3 May 1952. Dr. Daeumling traveled by train from his residence in Germany to Zurich and then by air (TWA) on 14 January 1954. He took the utmost precautions to keep his name from becoming known to any travel agency, ticket office, or hotel management. He explained to a confident that he wished to evade the attention of the British occupation authorities in Germany, which explained why he did not travel by air from Germany.
- 4. Dr. Daeumling's wife and three daughters are believed to have joined him in Cairo. Liselotte Daeumling, nee Hentschel, was born on 19 January 1909 and holds passport #5082558 issued at Muelheim/Ruhr. The three maughters are named Ingrun, Grauke, and Gisela. The last residence of Dr. Daeumling's wife was 40 von Bock Street, Muelheim.

#### 11. Schaup

5. Lt. Schaup (fnu) drew up the provisional regulations for infantry training which were used by the third battalian of the Egyptian Test Combat Brigade at Camp Huckstep. ### Colonel Ferchl

(The following biographic information on Daeumling is based on SS personnal records on file in the Berlin Document Center)

Joachim Daeumling was born on January 25, 1910 at Bungerhof in Oldenburg. He was raised in the Evangelical (Lutheran) faith, but left the Church in 1938, thereafter professing "Deism." Daeumling joined the Nazi Party on May 1, 1933 and became a member of the CS two weeks later. From 1937 until 1938 he served in the German Army, attaining the rank of a non-commissioned officer of the reserve.

Having received the degree of doctor of law, Daeurling seems to have entered the employ of the Security Police (Sicherheitsdienst - SD) of the SS High Command (Reichssicherheitshauptamt - RSHA) about 1938, immediately after passing the state law examinations.

The highest ranks which Dr. Daeumling attained in the SD and SS seem to have been, respectively, <u>Oberregierungsrat</u> (senior government councilor) and SS-<u>Obersturnbannfuchrer</u> (lieutenant colonel of the SS). He received both promotions on Fovember 9, 1943.

Daeumling was married in 1937. Between 1938 and 1943 his wife bore him four children, all named after prehistoric Germans.

Subject, who now lives in BIELEFELD, Heeperstr. 304, quit his work for the Egyptians sometime prior to 1957. He returned to Germany and tried to pick up the threads of life. His Nazi and Egyptian past stood in his way. Only with the aid of leading members of the FDP was he able to get permission to practice law in N R W where he is now a "Justiziar" for a German firm. It is possible that he is still active intelligencewise although GWI TRSTEIN doubts it. He has rejected all proposals for contined [IS] work with UPSWING or any other service. (Erits and French have also tried.)

On March 10, 1965, New York T-1, who is in a position to furnish reliable information, made available a copy of an article written by Richard Z. Chesnoff, datelized Jerusalem, which article appeared in the New York edition of the New York Herald Tribune on February 8, 1965. New York T-1 advised that he believes that this article is the most comprehensive article available at the New York Herald Tribune, He could furnish no additional details concerning this matter.

Set out below is a verbatim transcript of the article furnished by New York T-1:

"'The Spider' Smuggles Out War Criminals

"By Richard Z. Chesnoff A Special Correspondent

"Jerusalem

"An exclusive travel agency, with a very special clientele, is operating out of a small Spanish fishing village: It's called 'Die Spinne' (The Spider).

"While it doesn't have a very attractive name for a travel agency, it carries on a booming business smuggling Nazi war criminals into hiding.

"Denia, on the southeastern coast of Spain, is what reliable sources here describe as but one of many stations in a vast, four-continent underground railroad enabling ex-Nazi officers to 'disappear.'

"The scurces say the international operation is backed by clandestine Nazi organizations with cells throughout Germany and In several European, South American, African and Arab countries.

"'Die Spinne' is one of them.

"Sources here say the operation is heavily financed by Nazi sympathizers, including 'some of West Germany's biggest industrialists.' Nazi loot, stashed away since World War II, is reportedly another major source of working cash.

"The network has been busy since the last days of the Third Reich. But now it is fully professional, and with the possibility that Bonn might extend the statute of limitations on Nazi war crimes it has recently stepped up its secret activities.

"The man who first began to spin the Spider's web, is former SS Col. Otto Skorzeny. A one-time Brownshirt bully boy, Col. Skorzeny opened Spanish headquarters for his escape group in 1949. Exphemistically enough, he fronted it with an import-export business.

"The Spider's web, the sources say, now includes carefully organized escape routes to Nazi havens in South America, Kuwait, Syria and Egypt: Clients are armed with false papers and new names. Jobs and homes await them.

Many have their families join them.

"Some top Nazi war criminals still at large, particularly those who think they are being tracked, have just kept riding on the underground railroad, moving from one hiding place to another. Egypt, the sources claim, has become No. 1 haven for Nazis on the run. They charge that President Nasser's government is giving full assistance to the network, including visas and 'good employment opportunities for the escapees.

#### "Zech-Nenntwich Case

"Evidence backing up at least one such case was given in Brunswick, West Germany, where a court last month sentenced convicted Nazi war criminal Hans Walter Zech-Nenntwich to 10 additional months' imprisonment for his 1963 jail break. The former S3 lieutenant colonel testified that he had escaped to Cairo with the aid of Egyptian embassy officials in Bonn. He later returned to Germany and turned himself in.

"Denia, Spain, ends one of the Spider's prime European escape tunnels.

"According to the sources, Nazi fugitives who have made contact with the outfit are spirited to the quiet coastal town. Once there, they check into a small, inconspicuous hotel run\_y former SS Col. Otto Bremer (Nazi party card No. 462775, SS No. 166881).

"Host Bremer hides his 'guests' until arrangements can be made to get them aboard smugglers' boats plying the Spain-North Africa line, safely out of Europe.

"At obscure landing points on the Moroccan coast other Spider agents meet the contraband passengers. Transported to Casablanca, they are passed into the hands of local Nazi circles.

"From Casablanca to Cairo, the sources say, is no problem at all.

"They estimate that over 500 former Nazi and war criminals have successfully fled to Egypt via this and other routes.

"The reception in Cairo is both warm and wellorganized. Reading the welcome wagon for Egypt's thriving
Nazi colony is 63-year-old Prof. Omar Amin, alias
Johannes Van Leers, formerly an expert on Jewish questions
for the Goebbels propaganda ministry and today reportedly
head of the 'Jewish Department' of Egypt's Ministry for
National Guidance.

"It is Van Leers' job, the sources say, to process the new arrivals, check on their 'war-time talents' and then recommend them for jobs.

### "A Growing List

"At least 40 such Nazis, they claim, have thus been recruited for top posts in Egypt's intelligence setup, Mukhabaret el Am. A number are serving as special advisers to Egypt's army. Others have become business men.

"One is notorious Dr. Hans Eisele, a doyen of the Alairo community, former SS 'physician' and associate of Dr. Josef Mengele, the Auschwitz death doctor. German scientists who worked in Egypt and then returned to Europe allegedly report Eisele is a physician for the German crews working on President Nasser's rocket program.

"Among other top Nazis whom the sources say were smuggled to Egypt by Spider are: Bernard Bender, alias Lt. Col. Ben Salaam, war-time chief of the destapo's Warsaw 'Jewish department,' wanted for war crimes by the Polish government and now reportedly Egyptian intelligence overseer for what's left of Egypt's Jews.

"Dr. Heinrich Villerman, alias Col. Naim Makhim, SS specialist in sterilization and now reportedly head of the Samreh political prison near Alexandria.

"Wilhelm Boechler, alias Abdul Makrim, one of the Gestapo commanders of the Warsaw ghetto liquidation and now believed working in the 'Israeli department' of Egyptian intelligence.

"Leopold Cleim, alias Maem | Wasar, former SS chief in Poland, sentenced to death in absentia by a Polish war crimes court and now reportedly adviser on political prisons to Egyptian intelligence.

"Joachim Doemling, alias Ibrabim Rustapha, former Gestapo chief in Dusseldorf and now reportedly officer in Egypt's security police.

"The full list, the sources say, is very long. It is growing steadily, they add."

on March 10, 1965, New York T-2, who is in a position to furnish reliable information, advised that Richard Z. Chesnoff is a Special Correspondent who furnishes articles to the New York Herald Tribune on a fee basis. He is not considered to be a regular staff member of the New York Herald Tribune.

New York T-2 stated that Chesnoff is a replacement for Mr. Al Rosenfeld, a National Broadcasting Company (NBC) foreign correspondent who was recently injured in Cyprus and who is presently hospitalized as a result of the injuries which he received.

New York T-2 believed Chesnoff was a native American, possibly from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, however, he had no specific basis upon which he could base Chesnoff's home town.

New York T-2 stated that Chesnoff has resided in Jerusalem for a number of years and that he would presently be reached at number 64 Prophet Street, Jerusalem, Israel. New York T-2 stated that he has received no information which would indicate that Chesnoff plans to return to the United States in the foreseable future.
