

1 MEXICO – Tropical Cyclone CARLOS

- CARLOS is moving west-northwest, over the Pacific Ocean, approx. 100 km off the western coast of Guerrero state (Mexico), as a Tropical Storm.
- Over the next 48h, it is forecast to continue moving parallel to the south-western coast of Mexico and it may reach the coast of Jalisco State on 17 June, as a Tropical Storm. On 15-18 June, strong winds and heavy rains may affect the states of Guerrero, Michoacán, Colima, Jalisco and Nayarit. As of 15 June 12.00UTC, a Hurricane Warning is in effect from Punta San Telmo to Tacpan de Galeana.

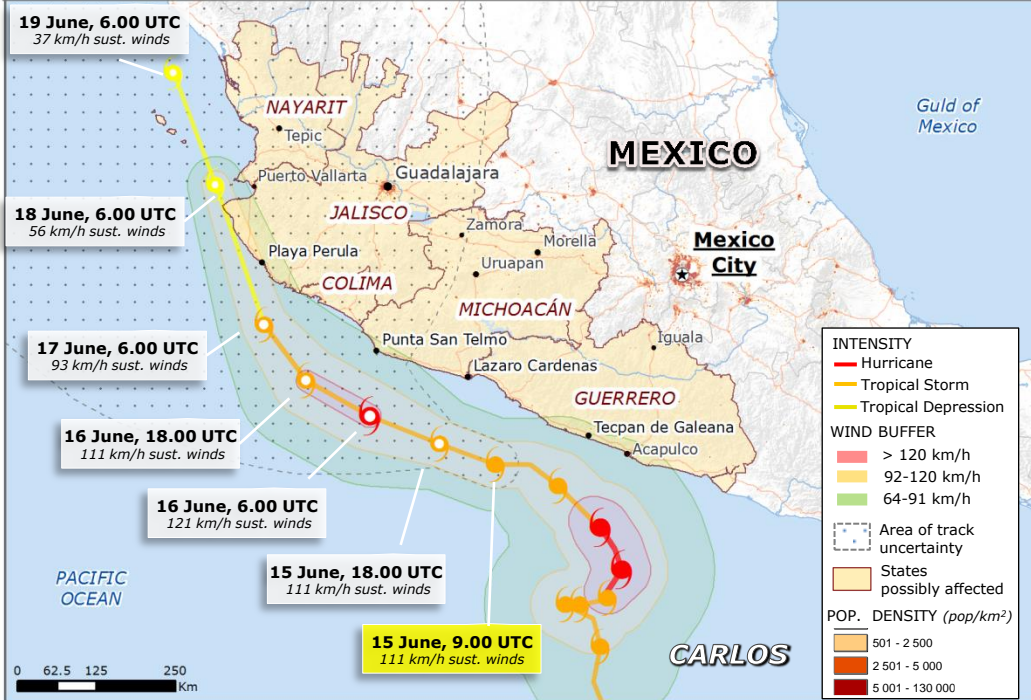
2 GEORGIA – Flash Floods

- Heavy rains caused mudflows and flash flooding of the rivers Vere and Mtkvari, affecting the capital Tbilisi and surrounding villages during the night of 13-14 June. As of 15 June, there were 15 dead, 9 people missing, 380 families affected (280 have lost their homes).
- The following districts have reported serious damage and destruction: Vake-Saburtalo district, right bank of river Mtkvari, Lisi, Tsodoreti, Napetvrebi, Bevreti, Tskaldidi, Betania-Tskneti area, Tetritskaro Municipality villages.
