



CHARLESTON HARBOUR or COOPER R.

This Plan exhibits the shape and form of a Lot of land known and distinguished, in the general plan of the public Lands situated on East Bay, near White point, in the City of Charleston &c. divided into Lots and sold by Commissioners appointed by the Legislature by the Number 2, and purchased by Christopher Williman; being sold in two parts or parcels (viz part lying on the East side of East Bay) Street, marked in the above plan A, and part lying on the West side of said Street marked B: the bounds of which are expressed in the plat by being coloured yellow. Shewing in what manner the said Lot Nº 2 is effected by Fort Mechanic, marked C, being erected thereon and on part of the adjoining Lots.
