100 articles in 100 days in a row.

No skipped days.

No articles written in advance.



#### Don't try this at home!

- Even some experienced Wikipedians would not undertake the challenge...
  - Or at least would not complete it...
    - Or at least would not repeat it...
- 100wikidays will improve your time management
  - Or at least will set for you different priorities for the next 3.5 months
    - Or at least will break your sleeping pattern ☺

#### Some other notable characteristics

- ... and the period of 100 days is \*not\* among them
- Set a goal which is difficult per your \*own\* standards
- Regularity and persistence
- Make a commitment (and stick to it)
- Interact, get inspired, inspire!



#### Some stats

- About 300 people around the world
- From 50+ language versions of Wikipedia
- About 18 000 written articles

#### About 1/3 complete the challenge

- Some of them: more than once
- Some of them: for more than 100 days in a row
- Some of them: in more than one language
- Some of them: in more than one sister project

 dedicated time and efforts to promote the cultural
 and human achievements
