

RALPH E. HOLMES

COLONEL Commanding

Commanding Officer of Lubbock Army Air Field is Colonel Ralph E. Holmes, a native of Irene, Ill., who at an early age moved to California and resided in various communities in the vicinity of Oakland. He is a rated Command Pilot, Aircraft Observer, Airship Pilot and Balloon Observer. Son of a Spanish-American War veteran residing in Walnut Creek, Calif., Colonel Holmes received his first airplane ride in 1919 by selling subscriptions to the Oakland Tribune, studied electrical engineering and Air Service R.O.T.C. at the University of California, Berkeley, and was commissioned in the Regular Army in 1926 by examination. He received lighter-than-air pilot training and communications training at Air Corps schools. After serving in stations throughout the United States, he was assigned to duty in Hawaii from 1932 to 1935, and upon his return, entered pilot training in airplanes at Randolph Field and graduated from Kelly Field

in 1936. He remained at Kelly Field, the "cradle of the Air Corps," as Commandant of Flying Cadets and Post Signal Officer until 1939, and completed the Air Corps Tactical School at Maxwell Field, Alabama, the latter part of the same year, returning to San Antonio to organize and command the 23rd Pursuit Squadron and later the 63rd Air Base Group at Brooks Field. From August, 1941, to August, 1942, he was Project Officer, Executive Officer and Commanding Officer of Lake Charles, La., Army Air Field, an advanced single engine flying school. He later served as Project Officer at Aloe Army Air Field, near Victoria, Texas, and on the staff of the Commanding General of the Central Flying Training Command in the Supply Division at Randolph Field, Texas, until March 24, 1943, when he succeeded Colonel Thomas L. Gilbert, first Commanding Officer of LAAF and veteran flier of World War I. Colonel and Mrs. Holmes have two children, Marjorie and Ralph E. Holmes, Jr.

THE STORY OF LUBBOCK ARMY AIR FIELD

Where roving bands of Comanche and Kiowa Indians once hunted buffalo by the thousands, where Texas Rangers under Colonel Sul Ross and Army scouts under General R. S. Mackenzie of old Fort Concho intercepted the savages in the 1870's and where trail herds from West Texas ranches once rolled along the chain of small lakes which formed the Yellowhouse Canyon Trail to markets in the Rocky Mountain region,—here the United States Army Air Forces now train hundreds of young aviators to fly twin-engine ships and to do battle against modern enemies of civilization, the Nazis and the Japs.

Lubbock Army Air Field, an advanced flying school for future pilots of big bombers, transports and two-engine fighters, took its name from the nearby city of some 40,000 people, which in turn was named for Colonel Tom S. Lubbock, one of the organizers of Terry's Texas Rangers in the Civil War and a relative of Texas' Civil War Governor, Francis R. Lubbock.

Located 10 miles west of the huge campus of Texas Technological College (pre-war enrollment of 4,076 was slightly smaller than that of Carnegie Tech or Stanford University), the site for Lubbock Army Air Field was chosen in April of 1941 as the 1,400-acre tract on the Levelland Highway at the junction of the famous Spade, the IOA, and the Sanders and Wolfforth ranches near Hurlwood community. The Spade ranch was owned by the Spade brothers of DeKalb, Illinois, who came west after making a fortune in barbed wire, and the IOA brand was registered by the Iowa business men who controlled a half-million acres here before the big ranches were cut up into stock farms, some of which today are dotted with oil derricks of the Permian Basin pool.

LAAF is the second oldest twin-engine flying school of the Army Air Forces Central Flying Training Command with headquarters at Randolph Field, Texas, the oldest being Ellington Field, Houston.

On April 15, 1941, a board which had been named by then Brigadier General Gerald C. Brant, then and now Commanding General of the Central Flying Training Command, was convened in Lubbock. It consisted of Major J. R. Morgan of the Air Corps, Major James H. Stratton of the U. S. Army Engineers and Colonel R. K. Simpson of the Medical Corps. General Brant and a member of his personal staff, then Major Carl R. Storrie, met with them. The board inspected the site of land which the City of Lubbock had bought the previous year from the ranch belonging to Mrs. J. D. Lindsey and recommended that the field be located here. The city deeded the land for which it had paid almost \$50,000 to the U. S. Government, which in turn reimburses Lubbock at the rate of one dollar a year.

Construction of the base was begun in the late summer of 1941 under the following contractors: W. S. Moss of Lubbock, C. S. Lambie of Amarillo, and William G. McMillan of Lubbock, for the buildings; Holland Page of Austin, for the utilities, paving and grading; George W. Broome of Amarillo for the electrical work; and R. K. Landreth of Longview and Lubbock for the plumbing and heating installation. A complete "city" for future

soldiers of the sky was completed at one time under the directorship of Lieutenant Colonel Herbert M. Newstrom, project officer and later executive officer of LAAF for a time after troops had occupied the completed field.

A cadre of five enlisted men who served as administrative clerks during the construction arrived from Brooks Field in August, 1941. They were Technical Sergeant John E. Greiner from Altoona, Pennsylvania, later post Sergeant Major and now a First Lieutenant in headquarters; Staff Sergeant Leroy Qualey from Chicago; Sergeant J. Leonard Spooner from Indiana; Private First Class Corance Crawford from Beaumont, now a Second Lieutenant flying instructor in the 71st; and Private First Class Odell Moore from San Antonio. Their temporary headquarters was in the Lubbock City Hall.

On December 2, 1941, five days before the Jap sneak attack on Pearl Harbor, four officers who had flown up in AT-6 "Texans" from Brooks Field, near San Antonio, made an inspection of buildings which were ready for occupancy. They were Major Jack W. Turner, Captain James K. Kneussl, Captain Romain Griner and First Lieutenant Victor H. Walker.

Just before 1941 had passed into history, the first troops arrived—three commissioned officers, nine non-coms and 48 privates of the old 83rd Base Headquarters came up from Brooks Field as a security detachment. They were commanded by Captain Kneussl, a former Chicago lawyer.

Colonel Thomas L. Gilbert, a native of Arkansas, who received his pre-flight training at the University of Texas and his flying training in France during World War I, was sent from his post as sub-depot commander at Ellington Field, Texas, to be the first commanding officer of LAAF.

Colonel Gilbert's staff when the first class of Aviation Cadets reported to the new field to complete their flying training included the following officers:

The first monthly qualification roster, dated January 31, 1942, showed the following commanding officers of LAFS squadrons:

500th, First Lieutenant Thomas Spurgin from Norfolk, Virginia, who had just succeeded Lieutenant Bergen, named Intelligence Officer on the staff.

501st, First Lieutenant Stanley F. Jacobs, from Benton Harbor, Michigan.

502nd, First Lieutenant Gaylord W. Schultz, from Oshkosh, Wisconsin.

Company I, 32nd Quartermaster Regiment, Second Lieutenant Kenneth E. Coone from Champaign, Illinois.

Quartermaster Detachment (SC), Second Lieutenant John O. Gray from Coeur D'Alene, Idaho.

The first class of aviation cadets and students graduated April 29, 1942, at which time Colonel Gilbert presided at the new Post Chapel; Durwood H. Bradley, Lubbock attorney and World War I veteran, delivered the graduation address; Major George D. Markel, who had become Executive Officer, administered the oath to graduates; and Lieutenant Colonel James W. Andrew, Director of Training, presented the silver pilot's wings to the cadet corps which had just returned from a graduation trip through nearby Carlsbad Caverns.

Due to the press of official business in the rapidly expanding Air Forces following Pearl Harbor, Major General Hubert R. Harmon, Commanding General of the old Gulf Coast Training Center while General Brant was on duty at the new base in Newfoundland, was unable to officially dedicate the field until nearly two months after the first class had graduated. Then, on June 21, General Harmon told a cheering crowd of some 35,000 South Plainsmen and soldiers at the open-house ceremony that "Tradition says the Navy is America's first line of defense, but our Air Forces are our first line of OFFENSE."

During 1942, the muddy squadron streets gave way to pavement and the squadrons planted grass, shrubs and trees in their plowed-up areas to vastly improve the field's appearance. In general, the metamorphosis of a prairie into a modern military establishment was practically complete.

On March 17, 1943, Major General Brant, again Commanding General of Gulf Coast Training Center, made an inspection of Lubbock fields and announced that Colonel Gilbert, who had been ordered to another duty, would be replaced by Colonel Ralph E. Holmes, then serving as a staff officer in the supply division of Gulf Coast Training Center and a veteran of 17 years service in the Air Corps. Colonel Holmes assumed command on March 24. Other important events of the year include changing the name of the advanced two-engine pilot school from Lubbock Army Flying School to Lubbock Army Air Field and the arrival of Uncle Sam's nieces in khaki, members of the Women's Army Corps, for duty at LAAF to replace men for more active duty and to speed the day when victory shall have been won.

On August 10, 1943, the familiar name of Gulf Coast Training Center was changed to Central Flying Training Command, with headquarters remaining at Randolph Field, Texas, where the Central Instructors School is also located.

Lubbock Army Air Field has played a leading part in turning out highly competent personnel so necessary for victory in the air, and the record of achievement of its graduates should inspire every officer, soldier and civilian on the field to strive ever to maintain the lofty traditions of the United States Army Air Forces.


