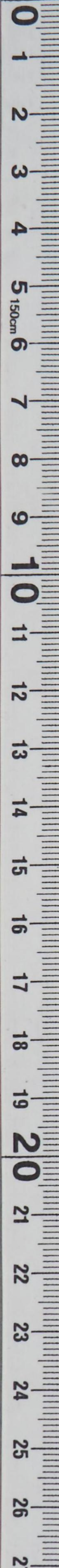

Wednesday, 21 June: 1200 Luncheon with CG, Eighth Army, followed by conference with CG, Eighth Army.

Thursday, 22 June: 0600 Depart Haneda Air Force Base for Itami Air Force Base with stopover at Okinawa enroute (Note 1).

1430 Arrive at Itami Air Force Base. Met by CG, Eighth Army and CG, 25th Infantry Division.

1430 Motor to Miyako Hotel, Kyoto
- 1530

Spend remainder of day in optional sightseeing and shopping in Kyoto. Guides and transportation will be provided in accordance with individual desires of members of the party.

(Spend night at Miyako Hotel, Kyoto)

Friday, 23 June: Spend morning in optional sightseeing and shopping in Kyoto and/or visit troop installations if desired (Note 2). Guides and transportation will be provided in accordance with individual desires of members of party.

Lunch informally at Miyako Hotel.

1400 Depart Miyako Hotel, Kyoto, for Itami Air Force Base (Note 1).

1500 Arrive Itami Air Force Base and depart for Haneda Air Force Base.

1630 Arrive Haneda Air Force Base.

NOTE 1: In the event air transport cannot be utilized due to weather conditions, at time scheduled for departure from Tokyo and/or Kyoto, special train will be available to party. Special train will also be available for departure from Tokyo on Wednesday night, 21 June 1950, if required. Running time between Tokyo and Kyoto is approximately 10 hours; i.e. depart Tokyo 0800 (2300), arrive Kyoto 1800 (0900); depart Kyoto 1200, arrive Tokyo 2200.

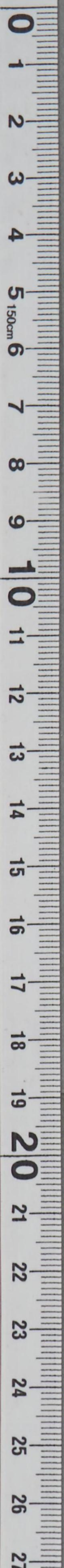

Note 2: Status of troop installations within reasonable proximity to Kyoto is as follows:

- a. Camp Fisher: 90th Field Artillery Battalion present on post. Camp is approximately 8 miles from Kyoto and can be reached in about 25 minutes by car.
- b. Camp Otsu: 2nd Battalion, 35th Infantry, present on post. Remainder of regiment undergoing amphibious training at Camp McGill, near Yokosuka. Camp is approximately 9 miles from Kyoto and can be reached in about 20 minutes by car.
- c. Osaka: Headquarters 25th Infantry Division and Division troops are located in Osaka. The 27th Infantry Regiment, regularly stationed at Camp Sakai on the outskirts of Osaka, is at present undergoing training in the Fuji Maneuver Area near Gotemba. Osaka is approximately 30 miles from Kyoto and can be reached in about 1 hour and 15 minutes by car.
