

## **BOLIVIA** - Severe weather

- Since November 2015, severe weather (heavy rain, hail, thunderstorms, floods, landslides, drought, cold, strong winds) have affected several areas of Bolivia, causing deaths and damage.
- According to the latest SINAGER-VIDECI report (as of 11 March 2016), 137 municipalities in eight departments (out of nine) have been affected, with 63 328 families affected, 19 dead and 835 houses affected.
- The department most affected is Cochabamba, with nearly 20 000 families


