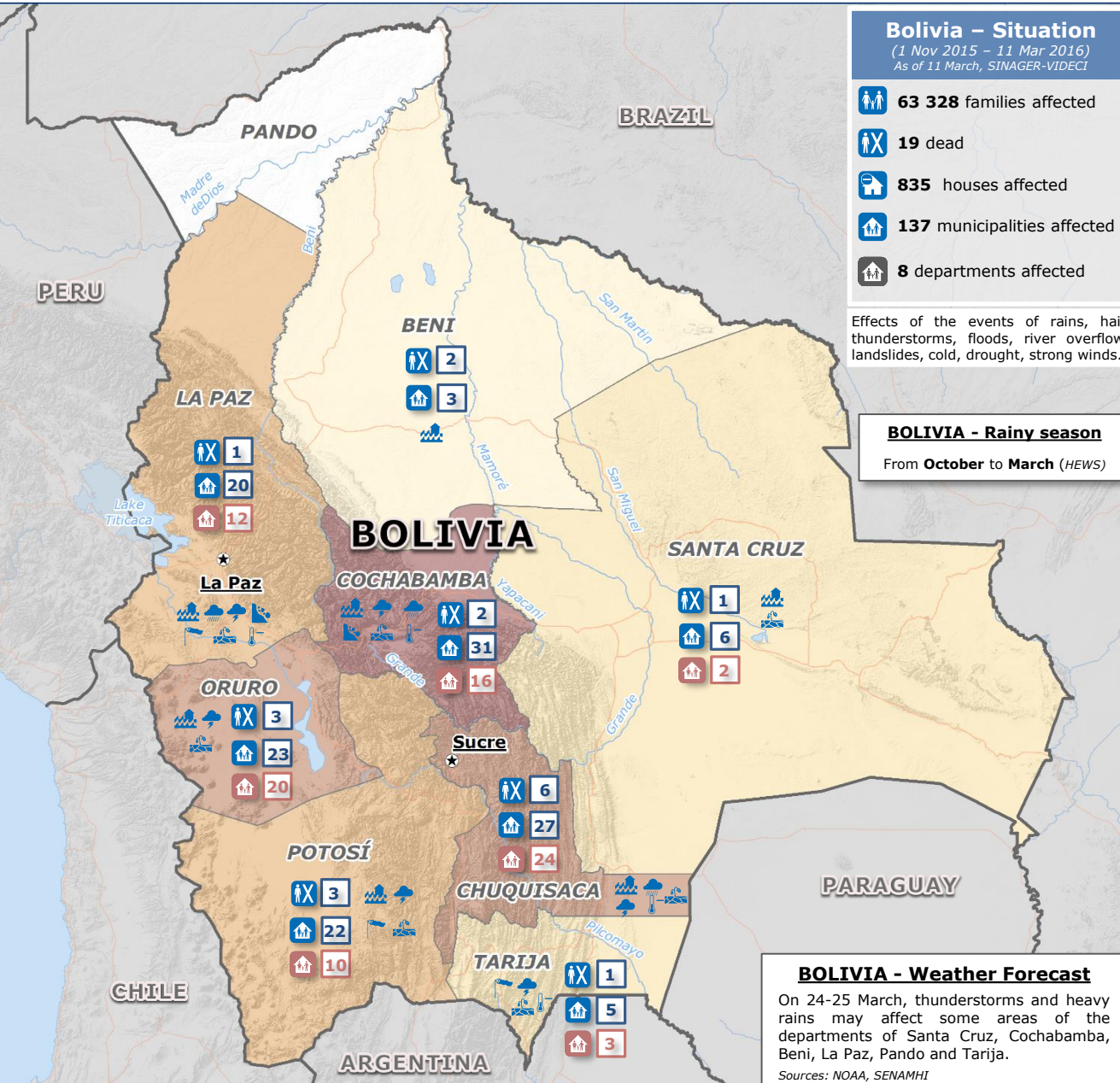

BOLIVIA – Severe weather

- Since November 2015, **severe weather** (heavy rain, hail, thunderstorms, floods, landslides, drought, cold, strong winds) have affected several areas of Bolivia, causing deaths and damage.
- According to the latest SINAGER-VIDECI report (as of 11 March 2016), **137 municipalities** in eight departments (out of nine) have been affected, with **63 328 families affected, 19 dead** and **835 houses affected**.
- The department most affected is **Cochabamba**, with nearly 20 000 families affected.
