Information and opinions desired by units of this command will be submitted through channels to this headquarters.

REPORT ON HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS OBJECTS AND INSTALLATIONS

1. Reference is made to Paragraph 6a, Annex 8 to Administrative Order No. 18, dated 25 December 1945 and Paragraph 3a, Annex 2 to Operational Directive 19, dated 19 October 1945, this headquarters.
2. It is desired that the commanding generals of all corps and the Commanding General of USASCOM C submit a report to this headquarters by 15 Mar. 1946 on the following matters relating to historical, cultural and religious objects and installations within the area of their command:
  - a. Damage incurred during occupation.
  - b. Continuing sources of possible damage.
  - c. Measures taken to preserve and protect, whether by military or civil authority, and their adequacy.
3. Specialist personnel will be made available on request to assist in the preparation of the report or to advise on desirable protective measures. If such personnel is desired, request will be submitted to this headquarters, attention Military Government Section.
4. The report will be submitted in triplicate to this headquarters, attention Military Government Section.
