1. The Tokuyama Property Custodian Branch, Yamaguchi Branch, Hiroshima Finance Bureau reports that the 81 Fighter Wing, RAAF, BCOF, while it was stationed at Bofu, Yamaguchi Prefecture commandeered the subject motor driven launch from the Ex-3rd Naval Fuel Depot 20 September 1947, it was listed for reparations under code number 45-7-770. The Finance Bureau representatives have been unable to locate it since the 81 Fighter Wing, RAAF, BCOF, moved to Iwakuni City, Yamaguchi Prefecture.

2. This launch weighs 6 tons, is 11 meters long, 2.7 meters wide and has a draught of 1.2 meters.

3. Request that the Chugoku Civil Affairs Region be notified as to the present status of this launch.

1. Reference is SCAPIN 1355, 22 November 1946, subject: "Permit for Conversion and Reconversion of Industrial Plants."

2. Inspection of reparation facilities in Chugoku region indicates that the provisions of reference memorandum are not being enforced by the agencies of the Japanese Government charged with custodial responsibility. Some plants are producing items not authorized on permit and several installations are using reparations items which have not been placed in authorized use.

3. Request that a report on all reparations plants under custodial responsibility of your agency be submitted to the Chugoku Civil Affairs Region on or before 15 February 1950. This report will include the following information:

- a. Name and code number of reparations installation
- b. Address of installation
- c. Copy of conversion or reconversion permit
- d. List of items in actual production
- e. Copy of application, giving date of submission, if an application for a new or change of present conversion or reconversion permit is pending approval from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
- f. List, by code number and name, of reparations items in authorized use, giving date and issuing headquarters of letter of authorization
- g. List, by code number and name, of reparations items in use without permission for authorized use.
- h. List, by code number and name, of reparations items on application for authorized use permission, giving date of submission of application to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

4. It is further requested that:

a. The production or repair of any item in any reparation plant in Chugoku region that is not authorized by official permit in compliance with reference, SCAPIN 1355, be stopped immediately and no unauthorized operation be permitted in the future.

b. Any reparation item not in officially permitted authorized use, now placed in "temporary operation" and required for authorized production be placed on application to the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers prior to 15 February 1950.

c. All items now in temporary operation which are not placed on application for authorized use as directed in paragraph 4b, above, be processed, at users expense, for storage and returned to dead storage within the reparation plant to which they belong on or before 15 February 1950.

d. No reparations items be placed in use in the future, prior to obtaining permission for authorized use from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
