MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Packing of Machinery and Equipment Looted  
from China

1. Reference is made to the following memoranda to the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers:

a. File AG 387.6 (22 Jul 47)REF, SCAPIN 1751, 22 July 1947, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Equipment and Records Allocated to Claimant Nations Under the Reparations Program"

b. File AG 386.6 (13 Feb 48)CPC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 13 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer, and Delivery of Property being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program."

2. The Japanese Government is directed to pack the machinery and equipment listed in inclosure 1, preparatory to restitution to the Government of the Republic of China. The locations of the subject property are also listed in inclosure 1. The procedures outlined and specifications used in Annexes 4, 5, 6, and 7 of reference 1a above will be followed when dismantling, disassembling, cleaning, preserving, inner-packaging, constructing exterior wooden shipping containers and preparing of packing lists. The responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the packaging, transfer and delivery of the subject property are defined in reference 1b above. Instructions for marking of containers are outlined in inclosure 2.

3. Immediately upon receipt of this memorandum, the Japanese Government will submit L-1 or L-2 Inventory Forms on all property listed in inclosure 1 where such forms have not been previously submitted. CPC numbers as obtained from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, will be marked on each machine where that has not been done. The Japanese Government will return one copy of inclosure 1 to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian within fifteen (15) days from date of this memorandum, listing the L-1 or L-2 Inventory Form number on which each machine was reported as well as the CPC number assigned to each machine. Discrepancies such as incorrect nomenclature, CPC number, location, etc., will also be indicated on the list to be returned.

4. Upon completion of packaging, the Japanese Government will submit in sextuplicate, a list giving:

5. A separate report will also be submitted upon completion of packaging, listing the petroleum products actually used in packaging the subject property.

6. The Japanese Government will designate by name a representative to receive further instructions as necessary and will notify General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment within seven (7) days from date of this memorandum.

7. The subject property will be packaged within sixty (60) days from date of this memorandum. A memorandum directing movement to a port and restitution thereat will be issued at a later date.

MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Packing of Machinery and Equipment Looted  
from China

1. Reference is made to the following memoranda to the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers:

a. File AG 387.6 (22 Jul 47)REF, SCAPIN 1751, 22 July 1947, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer and Delivery of Equipment and Records Allocated to Claimant Nations Under the Reparations Program"

b. File AG 386.6 (13 Feb 48)CFC/FP, SCAPIN 1858, 13 February 1948, subject, "Responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the Packaging, Transfer, and Delivery of Property being Restored to Claimant Nations under the Restitution Program."

2. The Japanese Government is directed to pack the machinery and equipment listed in inclosure 1, preparatory to restitution to the Government of the Republic of China. The locations of the subject property are also listed in inclosure 1. The procedures outlined and specifications used in Annexes 4, 5, 6, and 7 of reference 1a above will be followed when dismantling, disassembling, cleaning, preserving, inner-packaging, constructing exterior wooden shipping containers and preparing of packing lists. The responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the packaging, transfer and delivery of the subject property are defined in reference 1b above. Instructions for marking of containers are outlined in inclosure 2.

3. Immediately upon receipt of this memorandum, the Japanese Government will submit L-1 or L-2 Inventory Forms on all property listed in inclosure 1 where such forms have not been previously submitted. CPC numbers as obtained from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian, will be marked on each machine where that has not been done. The Japanese Government will return one copy of inclosure 1 to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Civil Property Custodian within fifteen (15) days from date of this memorandum, listing the L-1 or L-2 Inventory Form number on which each machine was reported as well as the CPC number assigned to each machine. Discrepancies such as incorrect nomenclature, CPC number, location, etc., will also be indicated on the list to be returned.

4. Upon completion of packaging, the Japanese Government will submit in sextuplicate, a list giving:



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- a. Markings and contents of each box
  - b. CPC numbers of the property in each box
  - c. Cubic measurements of each box
  - d. Weight of each box.
5. A separate report will also be submitted upon completion of packaging, listing the petroleum products actually used in packaging the subject property.
6. The Japanese Government will designate by name a representative to receive further instructions as necessary and will notify General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment within seven (7) days from date of this memorandum.
7. The subject property will be packaged within sixty (60) days from date of this memorandum. A memorandum directing movement to a port and restitution thereof will be issued at a later date.



2. Inclosed are lists of looted machines under custody of the Japanese Government and control of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, which are "unknown" as to area from which looted. The Japanese Government is directed to concentrate all of the machinery listed in inclosure 1 in the Kurihama Looted Property Warehouse. All machinery listed in inclosure 2 will be concentrated in the Osaka Arsenal Looted Property Warehouse.



3. All machine tools and other large and heavy pieces in the inclosed lists will be fastened to skid units for convenience and safety in loading and shipping. The machinery need not be boxed or crated. However, if part of an item on the skid unit needs protection during shipment, a box or nailed wood housing will be placed over that part. Skid units will be constructed in accordance with instructions contained in Annex 6 of reference 1c above.

4. The decision as to the impracticability of moving certain machinery because of size, weight, fixed installation, etc. will rest with General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers. Request for permission to exempt such machinery from the provisions of this memorandum will be made to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, listing complete information on which to base a decision.

5. The machinery will be arranged in the designated warehouses in sections, with machinery of the same type in its proper section. For example, all lathes will be stored in one section, all milling machines in another, all electric motors in another, etc. The machinery in each section will be arranged in neat rows, with sufficient space around each machine to make inspection possible. CPC numbers, as indicated in the inclosed list, will be painted on each machine. In addition, tags will also be placed on each machine indicating the CPC number, former reparations code number, if any, correct nomenclature, and former location of the machine.

6. After the property mentioned above has been concentrated in the designated warehouses, proper preservation and maintenance will be given in accordance with instructions contained in Annex 5 of reference 1c above.

7. In order to eliminate the tying-up of railway cars awaiting unloading at concentration points, or held in various switching yards, the Japanese Government is instructed to carefully schedule shipments so that the number of cars arriving at any unloading point will not exceed the daily capacity for handling.

8. Procedures for the security of the above mentioned property, while in looted property warehouses, are outlined in reference 1d above. The responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the packaging, transfer, and storage of the subject property are defined in reference 1e above. Records will be maintained as directed in references 1g and 1h above.

9. Instructions regarding other looted machinery under custody of the Japanese Government and control of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers which is "known" as to area from which looted, will be forwarded at a later date.

10. A report that the actions directed have been completed, together with twenty (20) copies of the inventory of the machinery in each warehouse will be submitted to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers by 15 January 1949.

1. During the period 1 March to 31 March 1949, this unit of Civil Property Custodian co-ordinating with personnel of the Kyoto Military Government Team and Personnel of the Shiga Military Government Team accomplished the following:

2. In compliance with SCAPIN 1878/3 dated 23 October 1948 movement to Osaka of all base metals bearing CPC numbers located in Kyoto and Shiga Prefectures was completed during the month. A request was made to CPC Tokyo for CPC numbers for the remaining base metals that were not shipped.

3. Surveillance was conducted on all United Nation's Property located in Kyoto. Prefectural officials have done an excellent job in carrying out minimum preservation and maintenance work as required by SCAPIN 26 and 1370. However, a few discrepancies were noted in their guard set-up. Recommendations were made to prefectural officials to correct these discrepancies.

4. Two pieces of United Nation's Property: an oil station in Kyoto and an oil plant located in Otsu, Shiga Prefecture, were restituted to the Standard Vacuum Oil Company on 30 March 1949. Receipts for this restoration were to be signed in Kanagawa Military Government Team headquarters, Yokohama, at 1000 hours, 30 March 1949.

5. An investigation was conducted concerning a claim for assets in Japan made by I.G. Farbenindustrie A.G. in Germany against K.K. Mayeda



Narasaburo Shoten, Kyoto. Since Mayeda's office contained incomplete records and since the records of the German Dyestuff Company in Kobe had been confiscated and shipped to Tokyo CFC, the validity of this claim could not be ascertained.

6. On Tuesday, 22 March 1949, the publicity for the last in the series of public auction of property formerly owned by Nazi Germans in Japan, was released for the forthcoming sale to be held at 1300 on Saturday afternoon, 2 April 1949, at the Civil Property Custodian Warehouse in Osaka. This sale will be mostly composed of household furniture which was withheld originally for furnishing houses in the Hakone area. However, it was later decided by CFC to release these furnitures for public auction.

7. Fifteen (15) lathes located in Kyoto Prefecture and seven (7) lathes located in Shiga Prefecture, looted from China, were shipped to the Osaka Sugimura Warehouse during the period 21 March to 26 March 1949. This action was taken in accordance with instructions contained in SCAPIN 6147-A/1, dated 2 March 1949, subject "Restitution of Machinery and Equipment Looted from the Northwest Industrial Corporation, Shansi Province, China".

8. In accordance with instructions contained in SCAPIN 6395-A, dated 16 February 1949, subject, "Recall of Unidentifiable Looted Vehicles in Use by Japanese Government Agencies", 1940 Plymouth Sedan, Engine No. 1265 38 used by the Shiga Prefecture Police Department was shipped to the Osaka Looted Property Warehouse on 19 March 1949.

9. Mr. F. Hoffer DAC, Chief, PSB, CFC, GHQ, SCAP, inspected this unit during the period 16 March to 21 March 1949. Administration, operating procedure, and investigations in progress were discussed at this time.

10. Yen value reflected in investigations by this CFC unit for the period 1 March to 31 March 1949, is in excess of ¥4,174,650.



3. Within thirty days from date of this directive, the Japanese Government will submit a detailed plan for the dismantling, packaging, and transportation of the subject equipment. Reference is made to Annex 1 of reference 1c above for the form of report to be used and directions therefor. The dismantling and packaging will not be delayed by the preparation of this plan.

4. The procedures outlined and specifications used in Annexes 4, 5, 6, and 7 of reference 1c above will be followed when dismantling, disassembling, cleaning, preserving, innerpackaging, constructing exterior wooden shipping containers, marking, and preparing of packing lists. The responsibilities of the Japanese Government for the packaging, transfer, and delivery of the subject property are defined in reference 1k above. Instructions for marking of containers are outlined in Inclosure 2.

5. Upon completion of packaging the Japanese Government will submit, in sextuplicate, a list giving:

- a. Markings and contents of each box.
- b. Cubic measurements of each box.
- c. Weight of each box.

6. The Japanese Government will designate by name, a representative to receive further instructions, as necessary, from the Civil Property Custodian and will notify General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of his appointment within seven days from date of this memorandum.



7. The subject property will be packaged and stored in warehouses at Nagoya, by 5 December 1948. A memorandum directing the restitution will be issued at a later date.



6. The Kyoto R.R. Service Station (Standard Vacuum Oil Co.) resumed operations to authorized Foreign Nationals on 15 October 1948. The Higashinotein Service Station (Rising Sun Petroleum Co.) will resume operations by 20 October 1948.

7. Fukui Prefecture as of 25 September 1948, was transferred from Kinki Region to the jurisdiction of Tokai-Hokuriku Headquarters. Accordingly, CPC matters pertaining to Fukui Prefecture were transferred from this office to the Nagoya CPC office, Tokai-Hokuriku Headquarters.

8. 1. The CPC machines of the factory had not been properly marked. It was gathered that upon inspection the person in charge of factory had no cognition concerning the CPC machines.
2. Mr. Aoyama CPC Section , I Corps; Mr. Kitagawa, Otsu Finance Bureau and I made the inspection after meeting the factory chief.
  - a. CPC markings and wooden tags with CPC numbers on the 2 machines which Mr. Aoyama ordered as CPC were to be hung in front of machines.
  - b. There were 5 machines at the time of my inspection since then and CPC markings were made.
  - c. Mr. Kitagawa upon visiting the factory regarding maintenance fee for factory discovered that the markings on the machines were missing and related incident to me.
  - d. The disposition of machines at the time of my inspection on 20 August was most unsatisfactory and the 5 CPC machines were instructed to have markings in white paint. The dust and litter accumulated in the machines were ordered

to be cleaned.

- e. The five CPC machines had the wooden tags hung in front of machines and the numbers on the machines were not marked in paint but in chalk as I had marked on my last inspection. The persons of the factory understood that markings on them were not necessary provided they had the wooden tags. There were a few misprinted numbers which were given instructions to alter. Erased figures were to be marked properly in the future without fail.

Mr. Aoyama had in mind that only two CPC machines were at factory but Mr. Nakazawa of CPC Section informed of the 5 machines. Wooden tags should be placed on top of wooden covering of machine and that it was necessary for machines to have the markings.

There should be no faults or mistakes from now on.
