THE RULE OF ALLOTING DUTIES OF THE KASUMIGASEKI SHOBO LTD.

No. 1. The directors represent the company, and manage its whole business. But each director can take a part of the business according to the resolution of the directors conference.

No. 2. The directors can set a agent when he can not do his own business, and transfer it to him, on recognition of the directors conference. But the agent who is not a director can not represent the company as a director.

No. 3. The head of each section of the company directs his staffs and manages his own business under the commands of the directors.

No. 4. The general affairs and financial section controls the business of personal, general, financial, and other affairs which is not done by other section.

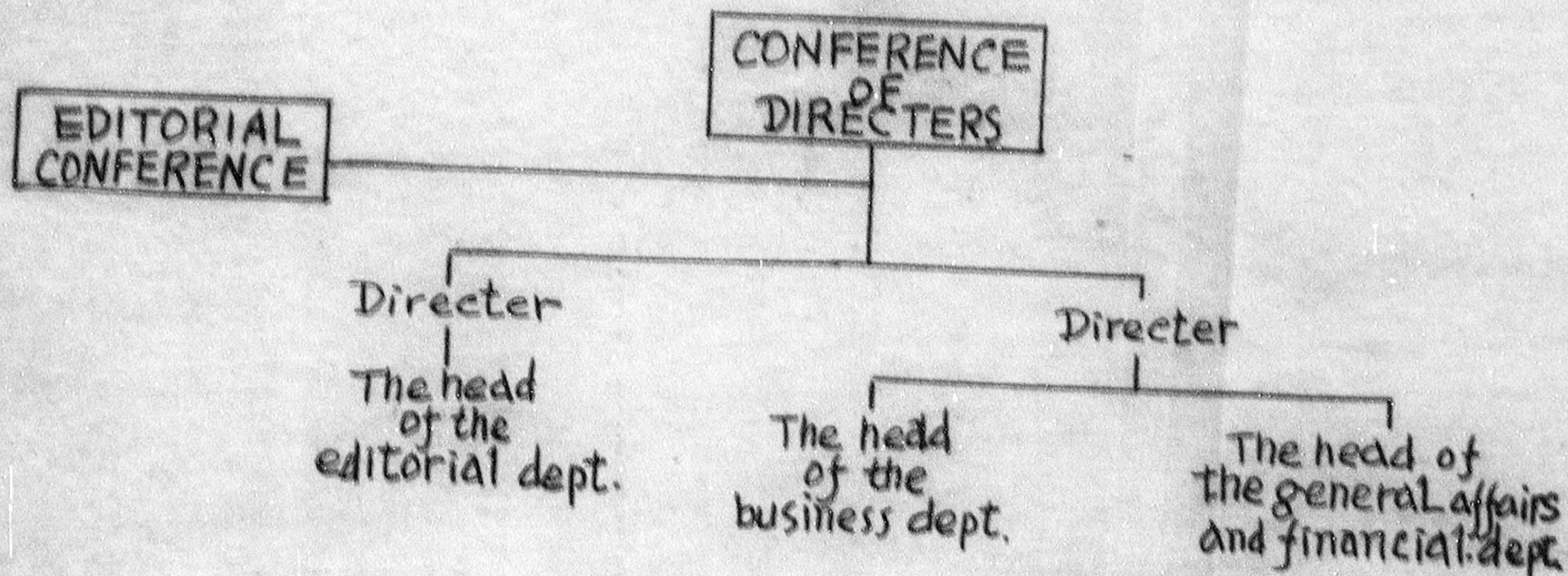
No. 5. The business section controls the business of making books, advertisement, propaganda, sales, materials, and safe-keeping affairs.
