I remember very clearly the entire matter of your friend's UFO film, which was submitted to me undeveloped. It was transmitted to Wright-Patterson AFB as you are aware.

I am attaching a copy of a letter I received in December from the Foreign Technology Division. In this letter Major Quintanilla indicates that they have tried to contact [REDACTED] to gain additional information and have had their correspondence returned after being marked "Refused." Please pass this information on to Mr. Villar as soon as possible. You noted in your earlier letter of 9 September 1967 that he had received my letter, but had not heard from Wright-Patterson. I made several calls to Wright-Patterson following your letter and obtained their assurance that they would write to Mr. [REDACTED] Union City, New Jersey. When they did attempt to contact him, the letter was refused..

As you can see from the letter, your friend, [REDACTED] can obtain his negatives from FTD if he will write to them and request their return. Perhaps he is not aware that somebody is refusing to accept his mail? In any case, there is no deliberate withholding of material or information on the part of the Air Force. The FTD people expressed in their letter that they would like to obtain more information about this case to make a determination on the photos.


I saw the objects the twenty-seven of June. It looked like this: When it moved, it waddled.
